**It's celebration week**

This is celebration week in Milton.

The town is celebrating the end of the long but successful annexation attempts with a community ball, free teen dance, bus rides, carnival, fireworks display and a brightly illuminated main street.

The Chamber of Commerce carnival at the Martin Flats gets underway today for the weekend with local stores offering tickets with purchases. On Friday the

Carlton Showband will be performing in Milton Arena at the Community Ball. The action there gets underway at 9 p.m. with advance admission tickets just \$1. A barbecue to be available during the evening is a further \$1.50 for those who are interested.

During Milton Council's Monday meeting members of council agreed to pay their admission to and also to serve the barbecue to invited guests. On hand will

be officials who participated in the annexation proceedings as well as other guests. Board and committee members from the town's municipal groups are also to be introduced.

A crowd of 1,200 is expected to be on hand for the Community Ball which will run until 1 a.m.

On Saturday evening the free teen dance is set for the parking lot at the Brewers' Retail Store with the Shanes providing the entertainment and Tiny Hopkins as M.C.

Free bus rides on the double decker buses for senior citizens, retarded children and invalids are available on Saturday leaving from the Mary St. parking lot. For special accommodation contact Councillors C. Fay or C. Smillie.

Monday, Dominion Day, an aerial fireworks display at Centennial Park will climax a brief flag lowering ceremony. The event has been arranged by the Parks Board with the co-operation of Hand Chemical Industries, The Milton Girls' Pipe Band and the Milton Rovers.

**Meter Co., Union sign new contract pay, benefits package worth 50c**

Terms of settlement for a two year agreement commencing April 30, 1968 have been ratified by the membership of Local 4574, United Steelworkers of America at the Canadian Meter Company Limited, Milton.

The negotiations were carried on at the plant in Milton and were concluded after eight meetings between the parties. The conciliation services of the Ontario Labor Board were not required as the parties were able to resolve their differences directly across the negotiating table.

Language was revised and introduced with regard to: Seniority.

Protection of earnings of day rate and incentive workers when transferred for the convenience of the Company.

Benefit coverage will be maintained by the Company for employees who are absent because of illness or accident.

If Medicare is introduced and any savings accrue to the management, such savings will be utilized to improve employee benefits.

Protective language if jobs are re-time studied.

Language re rest periods introduced.

The monetary improvements were as follows:

The Company will pay the full cost of Ontario Hospital Services.

The Company will pay the full cost of Ontario Hospital and drugs for pensioners.

The weekly indemnity of \$70 per week has been extended from 26 to 52 weeks.

Vacation improvements from four weeks after 20 years of service to four weeks after 15 years of service; also a new clause giving five weeks vacation after 25 years of service.

Shift premiums improved from 9 and 11¢ to 12 and 14¢.

Pension improvements - the introduction of full vesting after 10 years of service; increase in minimum and maximum pensions; increase in disability pen-

sions. Employees given full years of credit for service in line with seniority service.

A tenth statutory holiday added. A 15¢ per hour across the board wage increase to all employees, and a further 14¢ per hour to all day workers in the first year of the agreement. This

brings the minimum day rate to \$2.43 per hour.

Fourteen cents across the board in the second year of the agreement.

The total package cost of the agreement is 50¢ per hour, spread over a period of two years, including incentive.
