Town equipment

Consider emergency staff
Members of the Works Committee will consider an emergency staff for municipal equipment, Milton Council agreed Monday.

Deputy-Reeve Ron Harris expressed support for the proposal advanced the previous week by the mayor and asked for elaboration.
Mayor Best emphasized the town had a million dollar treatment plant including auxiliary power equipment, would have three quarters of a million eventually in trunks and an expensive water system. "You can't have someone who just thinks they know how to operate these systems", he suggested.
Councillor G. Krantz suggested present staff be trained, who are now in other positions, so they could fill in during emergencies.
A training program among the present staff and promotion when qualified would be of assistance, Councillor P. Barr suggested.
Mayor Best emphasized he was concerned about having enough people to cope with the systems in emergencies, whether it be floods or illness, and suggested the works committee investigate the best solution.

Close Main St. for two days

Motorists are reminded that Main St. will be closed in both lanes to all vehicular traffic, next Tuesday and Wednesday, Sept. 2 and 3.

The closing is necessary to allow workmen to lay the 42 inch tiles for the town's new trunk sewer project. Contractors promise they can cross Main St. in the two day period—they reached there Monday of this week after inching their way up Fulton St. from Oak St.

During the closing, traffic will be diverted to Pine St. However, a bridge on Pine St. restricts vehicular traffic to a weight of not more than four tons, so truck traffic will have to divert around the town perimeter.

Several other streets in Milton will be affected by the trunk sewer project in the coming weeks. They include Millside Plaza, Woodward St., Riverplace Cresc., Mountview Dr. and Highside Dr.
