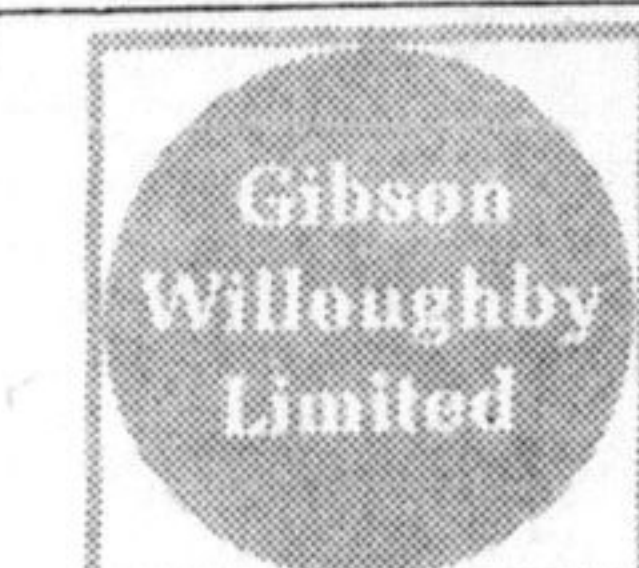

Ontario offers fine fishing

Ontario's proud tourist industry suffered a shocking blow last year when mercury pollution was discovered in some of its finest fishing waters. There is no denying that mercury is a problem here, but it is hardly confined to Ontario. In Canada, it has been found from coast to coast. And since it has also been found in the U.S., Japan and Sweden, it could very well be of universal concern. But for a sportsman's paradise whose fishing opportunities are legend, Ontario came in for the most publicity — some

aggravatingly true, some exaggerated out of proportion and some so downright erroneous as to tarnish its fine image.

Drop in bucket
Intensive government testing has revealed, however, that fish containing mercury in unsafe levels have been discovered in less than 100 Ontario waters. This is really just a drop in the bucket compared to this utopia of more than 250,000 lakes and as many rivers and streams.

Even in waters where unsafe mercury levels have been discovered, by no means are all species always affected. Often, only one or two species of several in the body of water contain a level of mercury unsafe for human consumption.

So there are millions of every species in environments as healthy as always and Ontario offers the optimum in locales — from downtown areas of some of its resort cities to the far-north Arctic gateway.

Fly-in trip
For the more rugged sportsman a fly-in trip to such rivers as Winisk, Sutton or Albany, makes for a once-in-a-lifetime adventure.

This is the land of trophy-size brook trout, where rivers tumble, often treacherously and always excitingly, toward James and Hudson Bay in the sub-Arctic. Where guides deem a stretch of water crowded if his party encounters other humans during a week-long safari. Where brookies under four pounds might be all right for a shore dinner but inadequate as keepers when you know five and six-pounders lurk in the waterfalls pool around the next bend.

Ontario is endowed with many fine flying services into these untamed waters, offering a variety of plans and trip packages. Typical is an American plan group trip offered by one air service at a cost of \$375 per person for seven days. The package includes transportation from Thunder Bay, meals, guides, boats and motors.

Try Algonquin
If you find the fly-in trip tab a little steep but still yearn for remote waters and hardy camp life, how about a fishing vacation in the heartland of Ontario's vast Algonquin Park?

The borders of this largest of Ontario's provincial parks are easily accessible by car but, from then on, the country is every bit as rugged as you could wish it. A circuitous canoe route through half-a-dozen of the park's lakes will expose you to some excellent deep-water lake trout fishing. Brook trout are native to all waters in the park but are more numerous in the streams on the north side. Bass are found generally on the south side. With walleye in the lower reaches of the Petawawa River and maskinonge in Lake Traverse, anglers can map out a trip to cover the fishing species they most desire.

Downtown angling
There are even places in Ontario where you don't have to leave town to enjoy some of the best trout fishing imaginable. Come to the Georgian Bay towns of Owen Sound, Meaford, Craigeith, Thornbury and Collingwood for the spring and autumn runs of rainbow trout.

Stay in a modern hotel or roadside motel overnight and before dawn a walk of a few blocks or less will take you to the trout-filled streams meandering through the town's business and residential sections. At lunch time you only have to climb the banks of the stream to find yourself within easy walking distance of a restaurant. Then back on the stream until dark. Rainbows in this district have been known to top the 15-pound mark, with five-pounders common.

To combine a bit of the rugged life with some of the modern conveniences, take a house-keeping cottage in the Muskoka or Kawartha districts of the province.

Facilities nearby
Here you will find a variety of sport fish, from muskie to bass, from walleye to trout. And you are always near a store, boat rental or bait facility in these colorful districts a short two-hour drive north of Toronto.

If you want to see a good bit of the country while enjoying a fishing vacation, the mobility and comfort of a rented houseboat might be the answer.
Try the Trent-Severn Waterway, stretching some 240 miles westerly from Trenton on the Bay of Quinte to Port Severn on Georgian Bay. Walleye, bass, pike and muskie may be found from the Bay of Quinte to Georgian Bay. Lake Simcoe yields lake trout, walleye, bass and pike, while brook and rainbow trout haunt the district streams.
