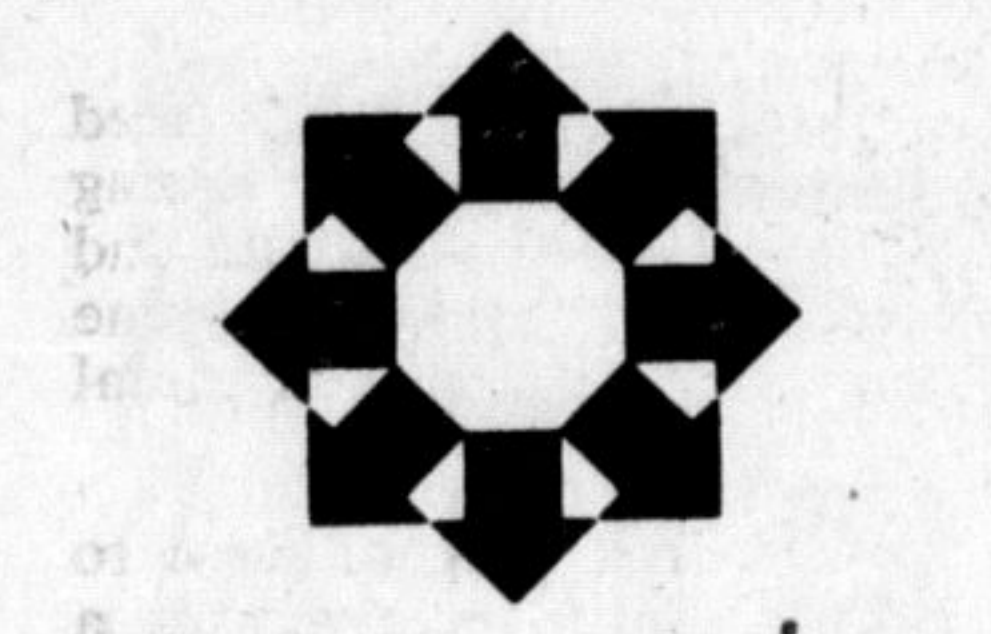

hockey in Milton before his accident—and wasn't prepared to let the accident curtail his athletic desires.

Place on team

Last fall he read a newspaper article about the need for basketball players on the Toronto Thrush Thunderbolts, a team affiliated with the National Wheelchair Basketball Association. He tried out for the team and was accepted almost immediately.

"Playing wheelchair basketball is very similar to playing regular basketball. Most of the same rules apply. If your chair comes in contact with another player's wheelchair it's a foul. A wheelchair is considered a part of your body," Brouse explains.

To play wheelchair Brouse has to have a heavy duty wheelchair with several built-in modifications. Some of the extras include special bearings, handgrips placed on the side of the wheels, and balloon type tires. When the athlete "speeds" down the basketball court he holds onto the chair with one hand and dribbles the ball with the other.

About a month after he joined the basketball team, he became a member of the Ontario Wheelchair Association, a division of the Canadian Wheelchair Sports Association.

In addition to the two sports associations, Brouse also belongs to the Steel City Wheelers. The group is a social organization in Hamilton which offers swimming to its members. It was with this group Brouse built up much of his swimming ability.

In January he swam 101 lengths of a swimming pool in Hamilton in a miles-for-millions type endurance race. The participants were supported by sponsors.

Brouse acquired \$90 as a result of the race and he used the money to pay his portion of the tip to Calgary. Another \$90 was picked up by the Ontario Wheelchair Association. However to be properly equipped for the Calgary Games his chair had to undergo some modifications and this resulted in another bill for \$118. His parents Carson and Aileen Brouse picked up the tab.

In May Brouse was picked as one of the athletes of the Ontario team competing in the Canadian Wheelchair Games.

Another accident

Athletes were chosen on the basis of their performance at the Ontario Wheelchair Games at the University of Guelph. However Brouse wasn't able to enter very many of the May games. He was involved in another car accident which required the insertion of stitches in his face. Because of the stitches he wasn't able to enter the swimming events.

What enabled Brouse to attend the Western Games was his past reputation as an athlete and the recommendation of a coach with the Ontario Wheelchair Association.

The coach is also attached to the Hamilton Young Women's Christian Association—where Brouse and the Steel City Wheelers practise their swimming.

The group practises at the YWCA rather than the YMCA because the women's building has more accessible entrance ramps for wheelchair athletes.

John Ronson leaves board

Veteran Burlington trustee John Ronson resigned from the Halton County Board of Education at the board meeting Thursday. After 12 years as a trustee Mr. Ronson is quitting because of a job transfer to Toronto. He works with the Steel Company of Canada and is organizational development manager.

Mr. Ronson was elected vice-chairman last year. A number of board members acknowledged the contribution he had made to the board. A replacement will be appointed to complete Mr. Ronson's term on the board.
