In addition to the two sports associations, Brouse also belongs to the Steel City Wheelers. The group is a social organization in Hamilton which offers swimming to its members. It was with this group Brouse built up much of his swimming ability.

In January he swam 101 lengths of a swimming pool in Hamilton in a miles-for-millions participants were supported by

Brouse acquired \$90 as a result of the race and he used the money to pay his portion of the tip to Calgary. Another \$90 was picked up by the Ontario Wheelchair Association. However to be properly equipped for the Calgary Games his chair had to undergo some modifications and this resulted in another bill for \$118. His parents Carson and Aileen Brouse picked up the tab.

In May Brouse was picked as one of the athletes of the Ontario team competing in the Canadian Wheelchair Games.

Another accident

Athletes were chosen on the basis of their performance at the Ontario Wheelchair Games at the University of Guelph. However Brouse wasn't able to enter very many of the May games. He was involved in another car accident which required the insertion of stitches in his face. Because of the stitches he wasn't able to enter the swimming events.

What enabled Brouse to attend the Western Games was his past reputation as an athlete and the recommendation of a coach with Wheelchair Ontario Association.

The coach is also attached to the Hamilton Young Women's Christian Association-where Brouse and the Steel City Wheelers practise their swimming.

The group practises at the YWCA rather than the YMCA because the women's building has more accessible entrance ramps for wheelchair athletes.
