SMALL ATLANTIC GOOSE MAY DIE

Aerial counts by Canadian  
Wildlife units and nine American  
states show that the Atlantic  
brant, a small sea goose, may be  
dying out. Only 25,000 birds have  
been sighted this year as  
compared to 200,000 only a few

years ago. Scientists fear that  
the bird may be suffering a food  
shortage and breeding problems.  
However, some experts feel the  
count was inaccurate because the  
bird may have changed its  
migration routes.
