



Flyers win two over weak Dundas club

Milton teams in U.S.A.

Four Milton Minor hockey teams will travel to Millis Mass. (near Boston) Friday night and return Sunday after a hockey tournament there.

For the past several months MMHA has been busy preparing for the trip. The trip is being sponsored by assessing parents and players a certain amount for the bus fare with the balance being picked up through sales of hockey programs at the Junior B games.

The tournament coincides with the opening of a new rink in Millis. Teams from Millis played in Milton last winter. Minor Novice, Minor Pee Wees and Minor Bantams will travel along with the Major Midgets. About 35 parents will travel with the youngsters on the two buses.

Milton Continental Flyers scored two weekend victories over Dundas to keep them out of any immediate danger of falling into the cellar. Flyers beat Dundas 5-3 in Milton Friday night and dealt the Dundas club their second loss by a 6-4 margin Sunday night in Dundas.

After breaking even in the first period of Friday's game Milton edged Dundas 3-2 in the second stanza and then upped their margin by scoring the only goal of the third period.

John Arnold opened the scoring for Milton in the first period when he converted a pass from Doug Anderson. Anderson scored Milton's second goal early in the middle frame from Gary Hunt

and John Arnold. Greg Chuchmach scored twice in the second period with assists going to Bob Fukumoto, George Mills and Angus York.

Insurance goal Defenceman George Mills planted the insurance goal on a play from Anderson and Chuchmach early in the third period. Jim Brush scored twice for the losers while Tom Packham singled.

Terry Mastine made 35 stops in the Milton net while Maher was tested 48 times by Flyer shooters in the Friday night game. Milton was assessed 20 penalties, 18 minors and two misconducts.

Billy Presniak got a double minor during the third period

when he tangled with Jamie Ayerst. Ken Dummit, Dundas captain took a five minute major for fighting during the third period.

It was in the late stages of the Sunday game before Flyers took the lead in that game by any more than one goal. The first two periods were topsy turvy contests for the better part. Dundas led 2-1 at one point during the second period but fell behind during the second.

Potted two George Couzens potted two counters for Milton, one in the first and another in the second. Big rookie John Torelli picked assists on both counts. Greg Walmsley, a relatively

newcomer to the club got on the scoresheet Sunday converting a Fukumoto pass. Gary Hunt scored twice in that game with Anderson assisting on both counts. Anderson picked up a goal and two assists during the Sunday game. Craig Fleming and Danny Nichols counted single assists as well.

Milton was levied with 15 minor penalties while Dundas took 14 minors and a misconduct.

The two wins give Flyers 10 points in 13 starts and made Dundas' plight in last place seem even more permanent than it did a week ago.

Flyers see two games again this weekend when they host Hespeler Friday and visit Preston Sunday.
