

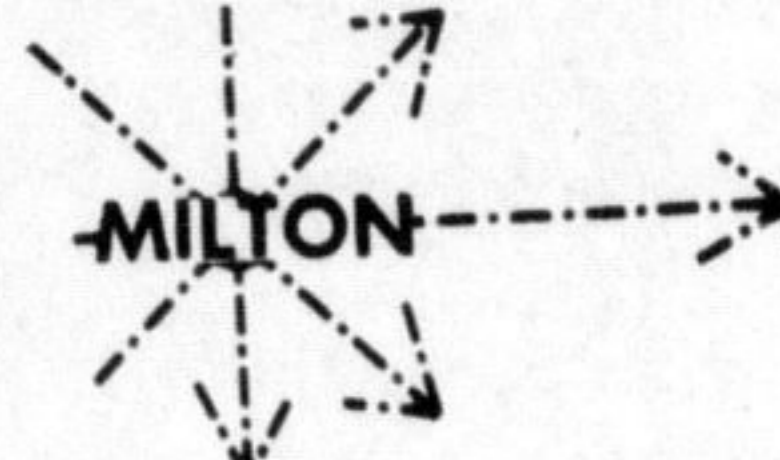

Dear Fellow Taxpayers and Residents,

On Monday 4th December, 1967 - you have the opportunity of assisting in the selection of the persons who will guide and govern the Town of Milton during 1968 and 1969.

4. Streamline the Administration - overhaul the Committee System - up-dating of Bylaws and Co-ordination of effort between various departments.
5. Increase Industrial and Commercial Assessment.
6. Relieve the Housing Situation.
7. Amend the Zoning Bylaw to provide for greater flexibility.
8. With increased development - improve on facilities for Senior Citizens, Library, Parks and Recreations.
9. Introduce a safety and mutual respect programme within the framework of the Police Department.
10. Obtain the best possible representation for Milton on the County Board of Education to be established.
11. Improvement of Public Relations - Personal - Corporate and Governmental.

If any of the foregoing are to be achieved, everyone involved will have to co-operate with an open mind and be prepared to concede personal ideas, in the best interest of the Town.

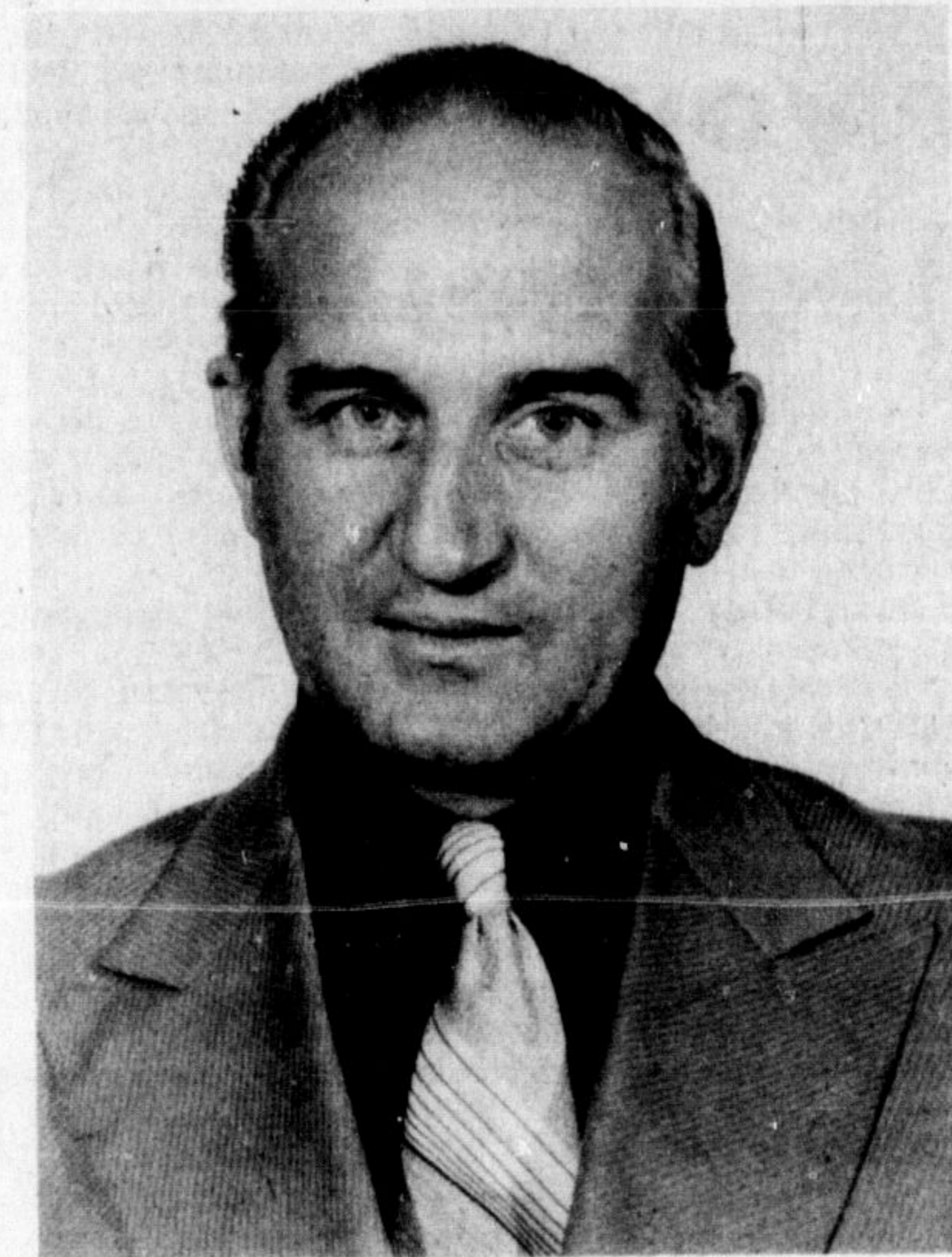

I respectfully solicit your VOTE for Mayor on December 4th.

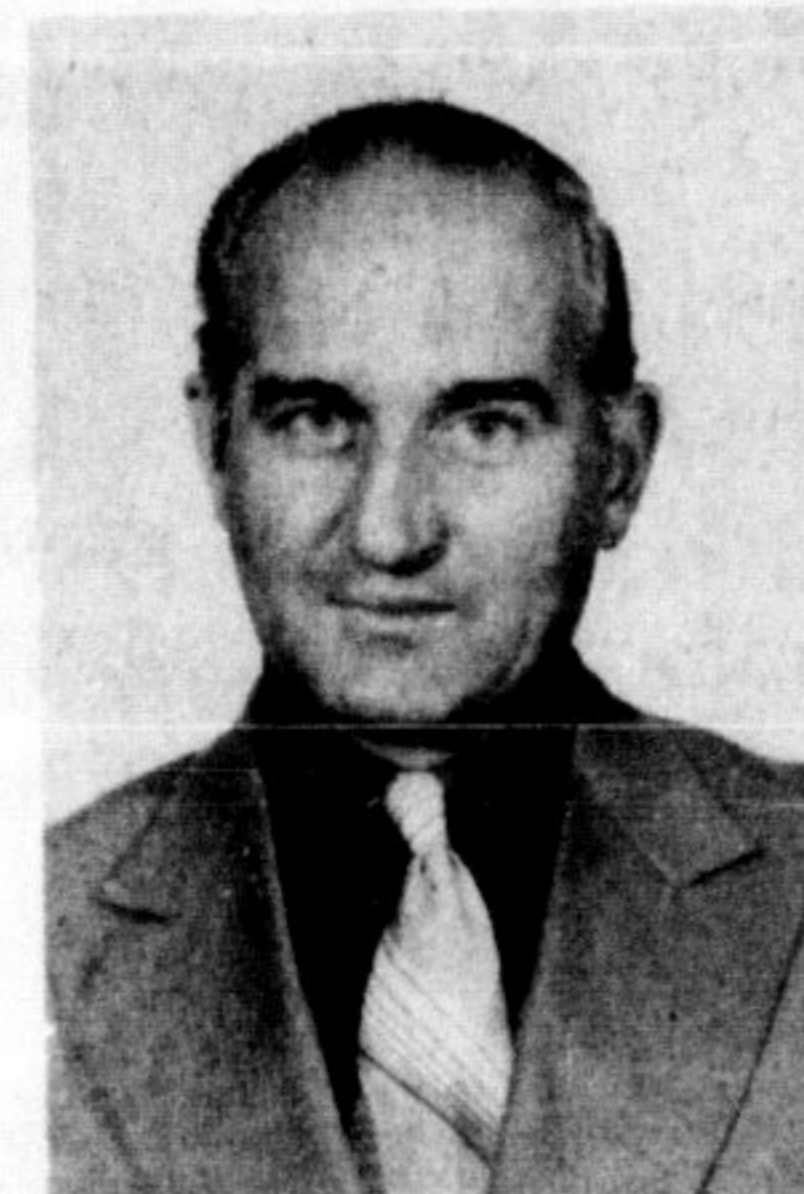

### Why should you Vote for Best?

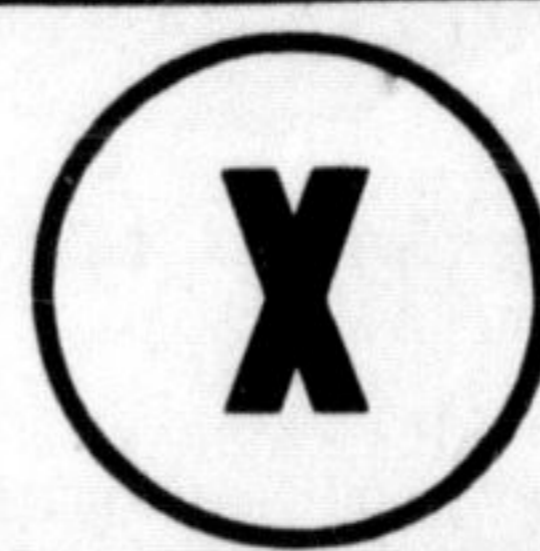
- School Board Trustee in Milton 1959 - 60.
