

Partners Schneider and Kann and four friends came to Milton on Wednesday to meet with Mayor Brian Best and clerk Jack McGeachie and explained their plans. While here they viewed town maps and heard an outline on Milton's sewer and water services, toured the sewage treatment plant and took a drive through the country surrounding

Accompanying them was Dr. Gerhard Eickmeier, mayor of the port city of Wilhelmshaven, West Germany, who is a personal friend of Schneider. Also travelling with them were friends and business acquaintances Councillor Wilfrid Otto of Giessen, West Germany, Dr. Heinz Geenen and Dr. Irving Lustenberger of Switzerland.

Mayor Best said the Schneider-Kann firm at first intended to locate their first plant in Mississauga but moved to Milton to be closer to the aggregate products needed for the blocks.


