Hilton Falls complete

By Bob Burt

Work on Hilton Falls dam has been completed. Hilton Falls is one in a network of dams in the Halton Region Conservation Authority's watershed. The project is estimated at \$1.2 million and is located just north of Five Sideroad in Nassagaweya at the Fifth Line intersection.

The dam covers an area of 523 acres and has a capacity of 1,800 acre feet. While the reservoir is smaller than Kelso, it is deeper and has a comparable water-storage area. Hilton Falls has a reservoir covering 75 acres.

The new dam will serve two basic functions, flood control and low flow stream augmentation. The latter is of significance to Milton's development. The population of Milton is allowed to grow to will be closely related to the ability of the 16 Mile Creek to carry effluent from the sanitary sewage plant to Lake Ontario without polluting the creek.
