



Revise by-law

Milton Planning Board should consider revising the town's zoning by-law to allow manufacturing concerns relief from parking restrictions currently in force, Mayor Brian Best said at a board meeting Wednesday.

Mayor Best noted current regulations require industrial firms to provide parking spaces on a square footage basis.

The mayor pointed out instances where as many as 800 parking spaces may have to be provided for about 30 employees in warehouses.

Some members were concerned about the possibility of having a new firm buy the warehouse and use it for a manufacturing purpose that would employ 400 or 500 people and not have

sufficient parking space Members agreed even warehouses should provide the property for parking but they wouldn't be compelled to pave the entire area if it wasn't needed for employees.

Secretary Ross Pearen was instructed to draw up an amending by-law for the board to consider at the July meeting.
