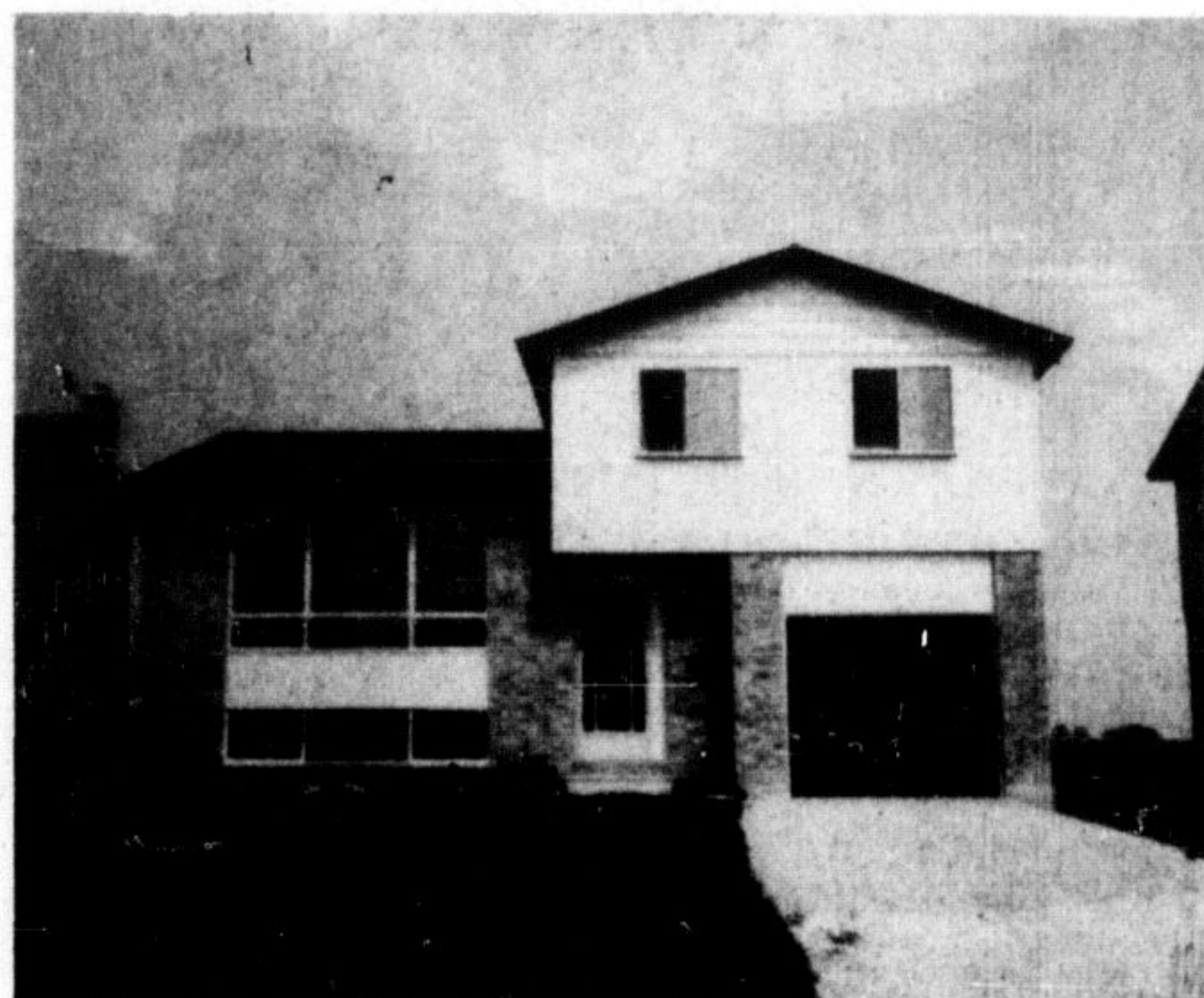

Mr. Dance figured the weather would have to drop to at least 65 degrees during the evenings before ice could be made.

Depending on the weather and providing no other problems crop up, ice can be ready within a week of the starting time. Both Milton Minor Hockey Association and Milton Junior Hockey Club will be planning to get on the ice as soon as it is available.

—Possibility of a bus service between Kilbride and downtown Burlington is being studied by Burlington's traffic engineering department.

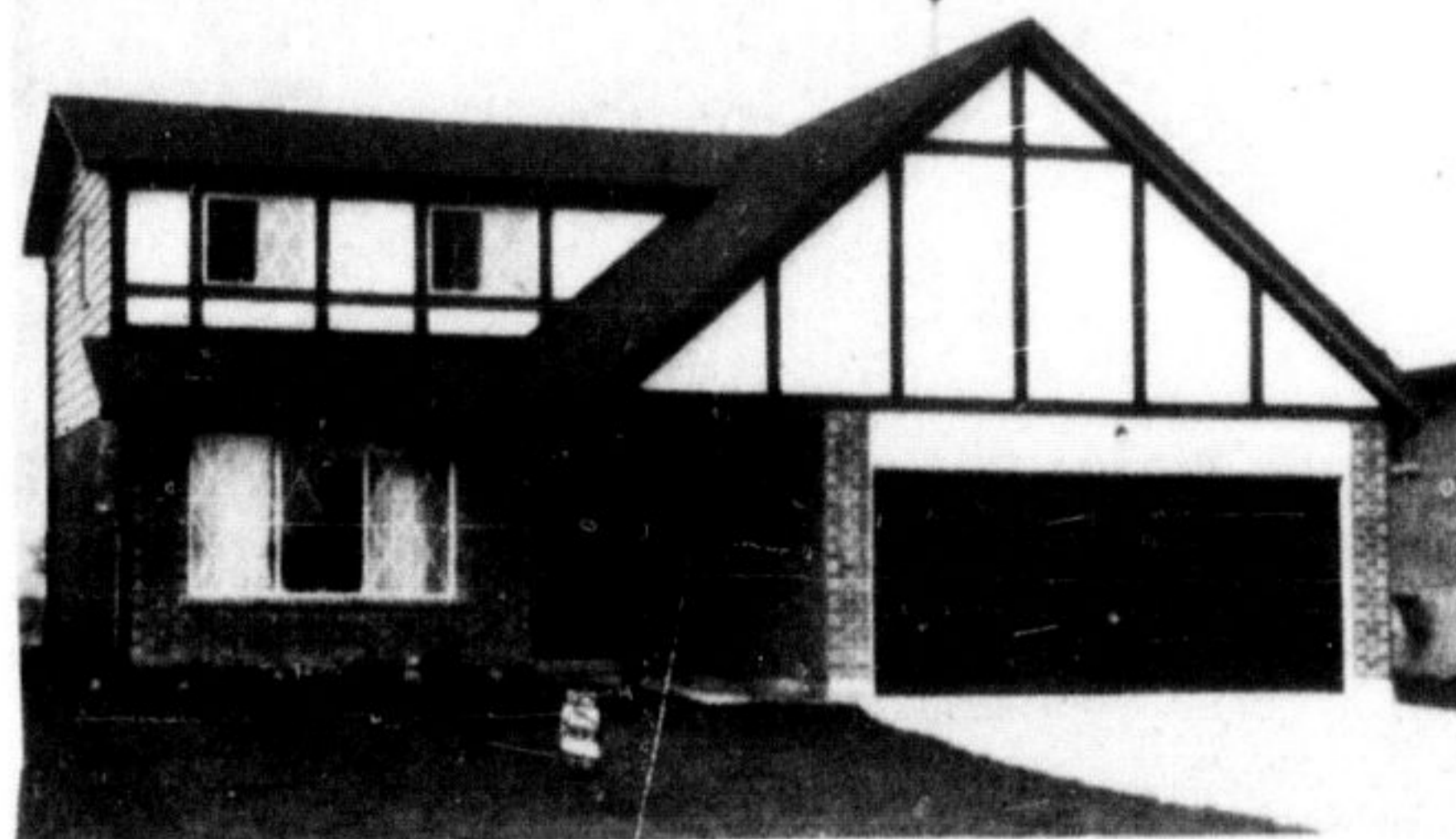
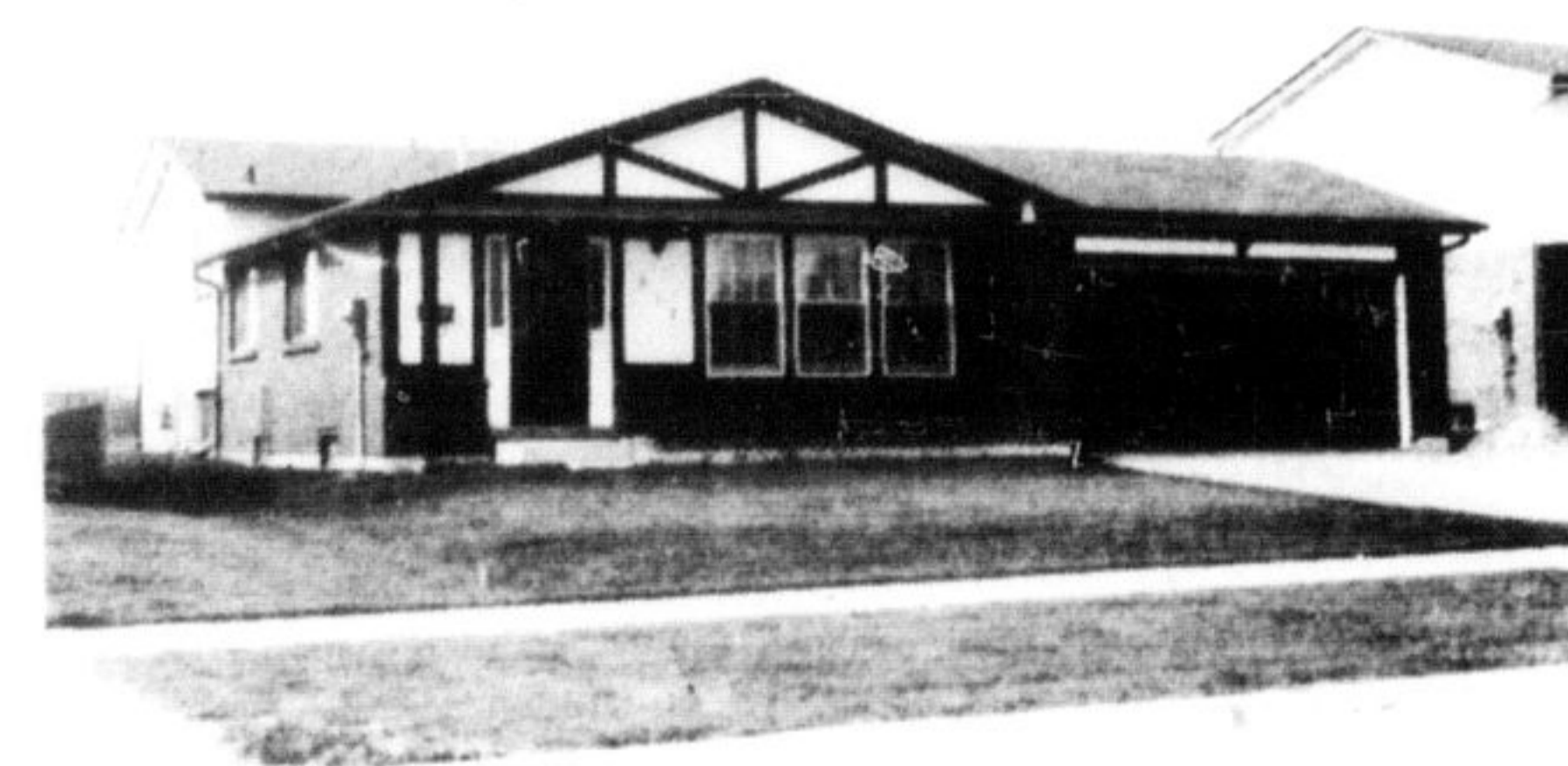
