This By-law will amend the existing Restricted Area Bylaw of the Milton Planning Area, being the Zoning Bylaw of the Town of Milton, By-Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 on proposed law No. 31-69, as amended By-law 31-69 presently Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 on proposed plan of Exprovides:

Section 6 (15) (a)—"Where a lot is used for a Non-Residential purpose and the interior side or rear lot line, or portion thereof, abuts a Residential use or undeveloped land in an R or D Zone, then a strip of land adjoining such abutting lot line, or portion thereof, shall be used for no other purpose than a planting strip in accordance with the provisions of this subsection provided that such required within 10 feet of a

street allowance.' (Amended by B/L 5-70). By-law No. 9-73 proposes to re-enact the foregoing, Section 6 (15) (a), however, the By-law also proposes to make provision whereby a planting strip shall not be required where a lot abuts land in a "D" (Development) Zone if that abutting land is designated, in the Official Plan of the Town of Milton, for a use which is the same as

the use of the lot in question. The reason for the amendment is to eliminate financia hardship that may be created by requiring the owner of a parcel of land to provide a planting strip that will not be required when the abutting land is eventually zoned in accordance with designation contained in the
