At a meeting of Nassaga-weya Council on Tuesday, Nov. 6:

-Council met with a deputation from Shasta Wells Inc., of "Crazy Horse", a Canadian franchise, who are applying for a permit to build a camp ground on Five Sideroad near the Sixth Line, Nassagaweya, known as the Anderson Farm. The plans include trailer and tent facilities, swimming, mini golf, a laundromat and supply store. Eventually the site would hold 500 camping accommodations.

—A request from the Town of Milton to dump garbage at Nassagaweya township dump was answered with a letter asking Milton to explore other possibilities such as Georgetown, Oakville, and Burling-

—The village trustees of Campbellville urged a caution light be placed at Five Sideroad and the Guelph Line and that ditching be done in front of the bank on the Guelph Line by the county of Halton crews.

—A farewell dinner is planned by Nassagaweya Council for Dec. 7 in Brookville Hall. Councillors hoped their "unwanted visitors" have vacated the hall before this fair. It is understood the mice have not received invitations!

-It was learned the Ministry of Transportation and Communications is in the process of installing signs at exit ramps on Highway 401. Signs reading "Do Not En-ter—Wrong Way" are being placed to prevent drivers from entering the highway's exits from adjacent roads.

-Council urged an investigation of the use of the old Orange Hall in Campbellville, following receipt of a letter from Milton Fire Chief A. E. Clement noting the wiring is not adequate for extension cords and urging an existing stove be replaced with a new space heater. It appears the building is used for storage of furniture and by a few local boys for band practice.

Discuss treasurer

Members of Milton Councilelect met in closed session Wednesday with Burlington treasurer Don Farmer to discuss requirements in staffing the Milton treasurer's department.

Council advertised earlier for applications for the posi-tion of treasurer but has not yet acted on them.

Firm gets insurance

Mayor-elect Anne MacArthur reported to Milton Council-elect Wednesday that the town's insurance was being taken over by Frank Cowan Insurance.

She told council F.W.B. Fitzgerald Insurance, which has handled Milton's insurance for a number of years, would be working with the Frank Cowan agency. She noted Nassagaweya's insurance had been handled by the Cowan group.
