WEED CONTROL IN LAWNS

<p>GROUND IVY</p> <p>Or Creeping Charlie, a perennial, it reproduces both by seed and creeping stems — the stems root at the joints.</p> <p>Control with a mixture of 2,4-D and mecoprop as found in CO-OP Chickweed and Clover killer or CO-OP Fertilin 10-6-4 Turf Fertilizer with Weed Killers.</p>	<p>COMMON CHICKWEED</p> <p>The leaves of Common Chickweed, an annual, are smooth and flowers white.
