



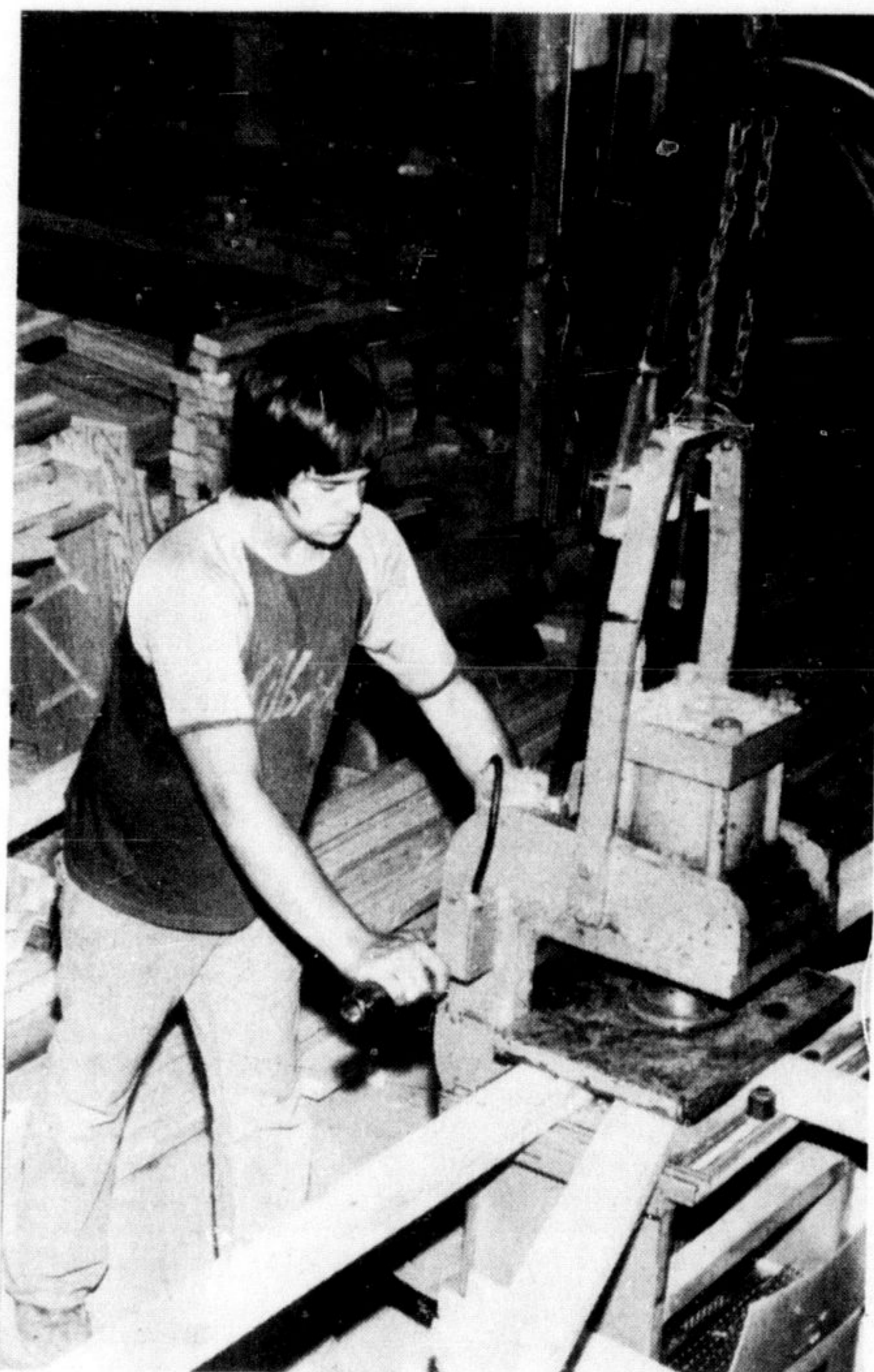

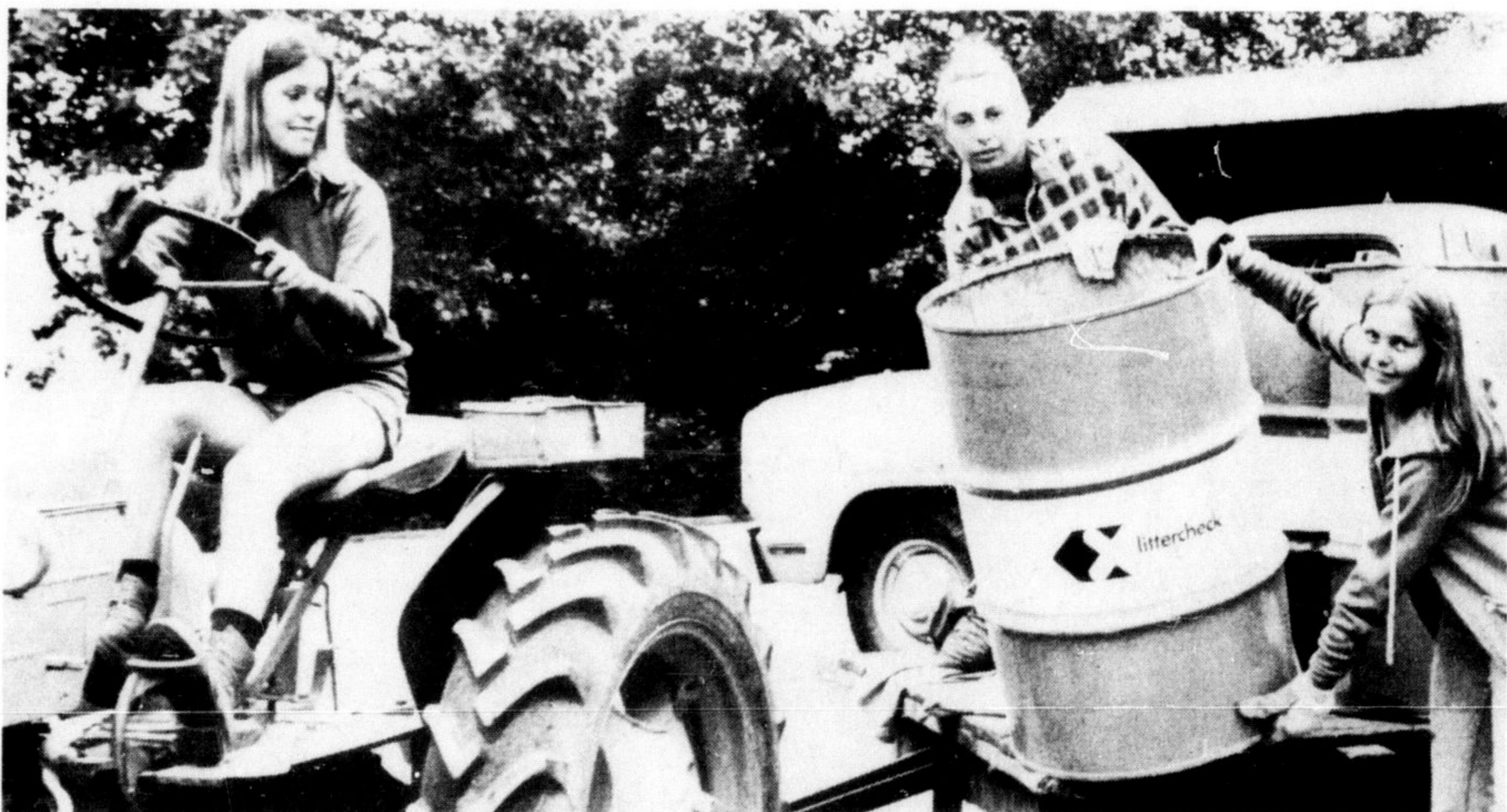

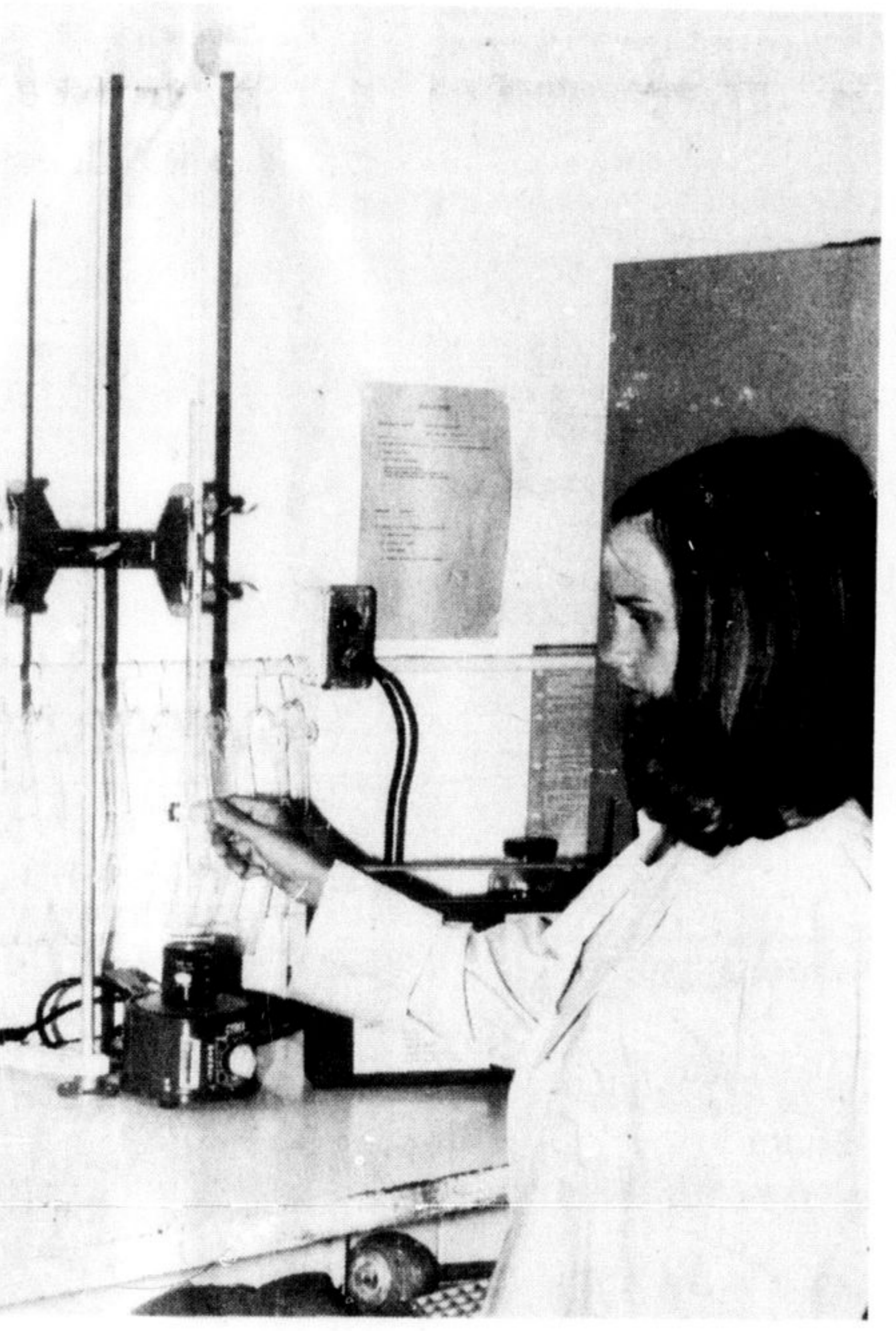

Black Creek Village salutes early printer

This month Black Creek Pioneer Village features "printing in Canada West" and salutes the principal news communicator of his day — the pre-Confederation newspaper editor and printer. Weekends in August visitors can watch special demonstrations illustrating early printing techniques. Black Creek's printer will exchange colorful anecdotes as he operates the various early printing presses and shows the print shop's collection of rare woodcuts, handset type, and various other pieces of equipment that were used in the early printing shop.

Not too current In his small workshop the printer-editor of the mid-1800's turned out the news of the day in the form of broadsides and weekly newspapers, keeping the citizenry of the rural community informed on local and foreign events. In many instances this news was months old before it reached his office.

The print shop at Black Creek, one of 30 restored buildings at the Village, was originally built in 1855, it was

moved to the Village in 1967. Black Creek is located in northwest Metro Toronto (Jane Street and Steeles Avenue.) Open seven days a week, it is administered by the Metro Toronto and Region Conservation Authority.

Summer school

Math classes in big demand

About 1,375 secondary school students in Halton have taken advantage of summer school courses this year. About 20 or 30 students have dropped out since the beginning of the session and only two weeks remain.

In addition to that 528 students are taking English and mathematics courses for grades six, seven and eight. Centennial School in Georgetown is the only school in North Halton offering that course. Lack of interest caused courses in Milton and other north Halton areas to be cancelled. "We would have run a course even for 10 or 12 students but there was no

response in Milton," summer school principal Willard Price said.

Night classes have attracted 120 people as well. Price indicated math was the popular choice for high school students, while French continued to drop off.

He noted there had been a continuous drop in the number of students studying French in the summer since it is no longer a compulsory subject. "Latin was the first to go, now French is going down."

Most of the students spending summer in school are taking credit courses but

about 100 people in adult classes are taking up sewing, typing and other interest courses.

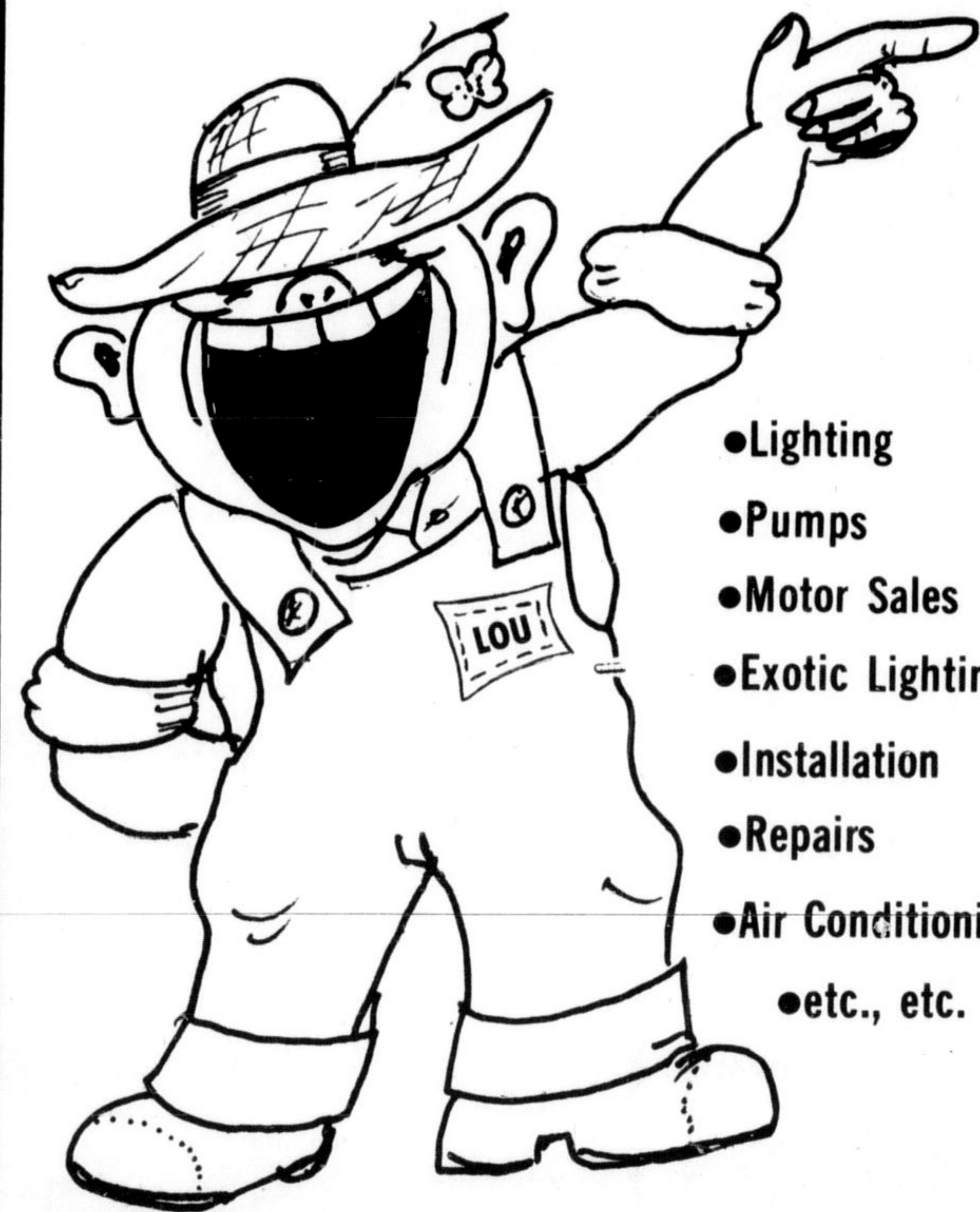
