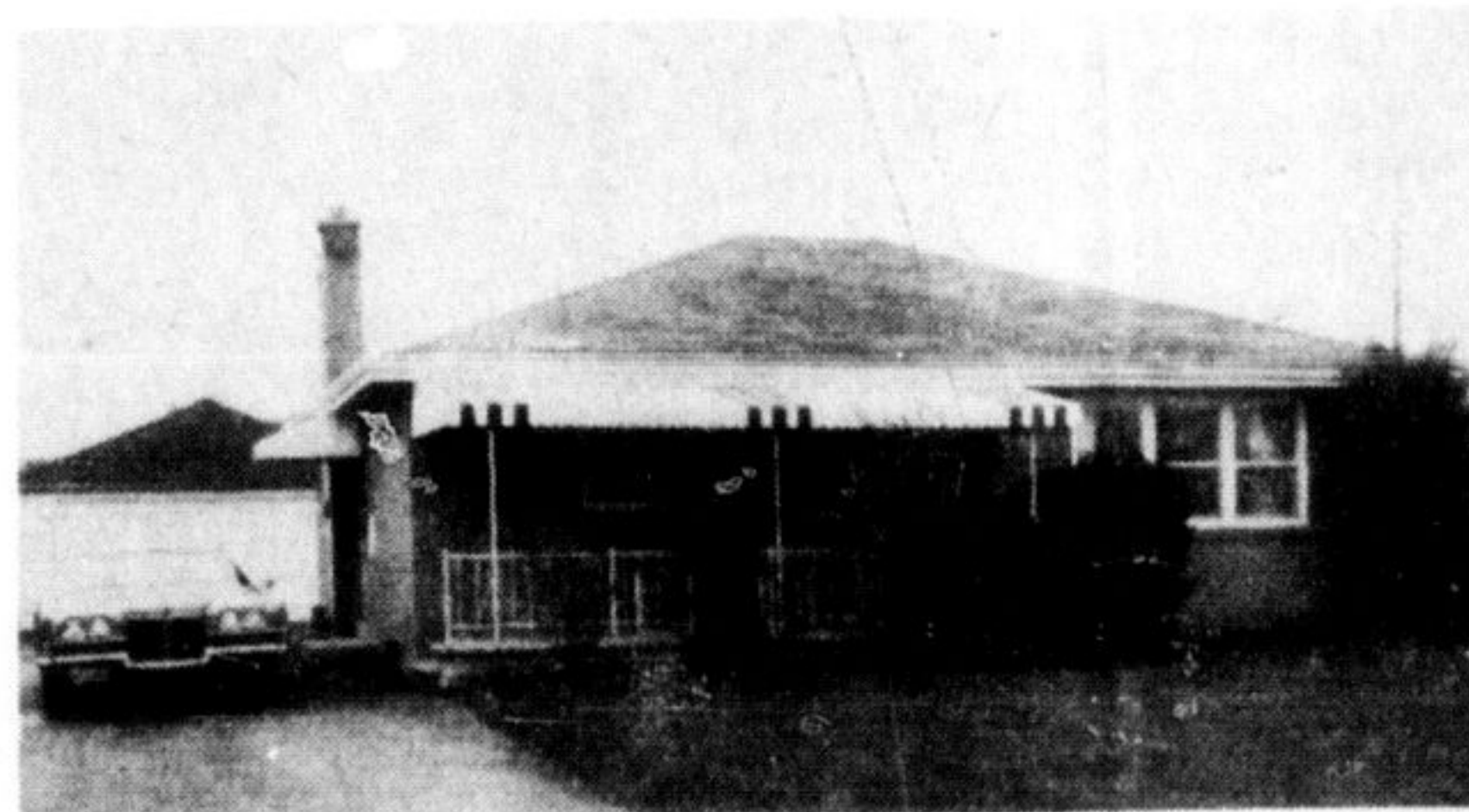

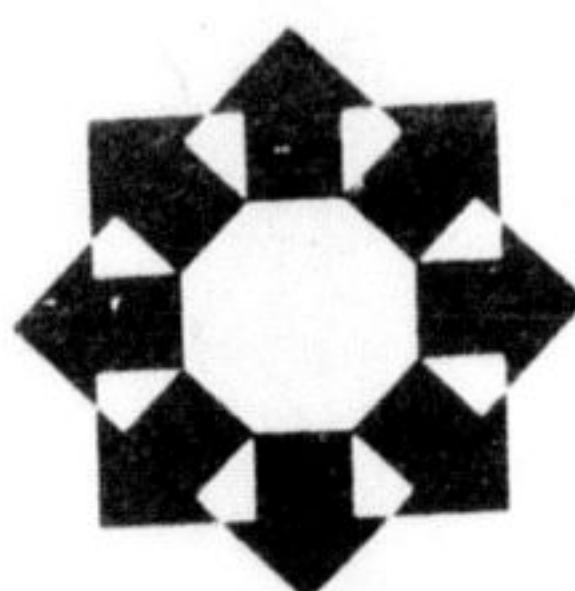

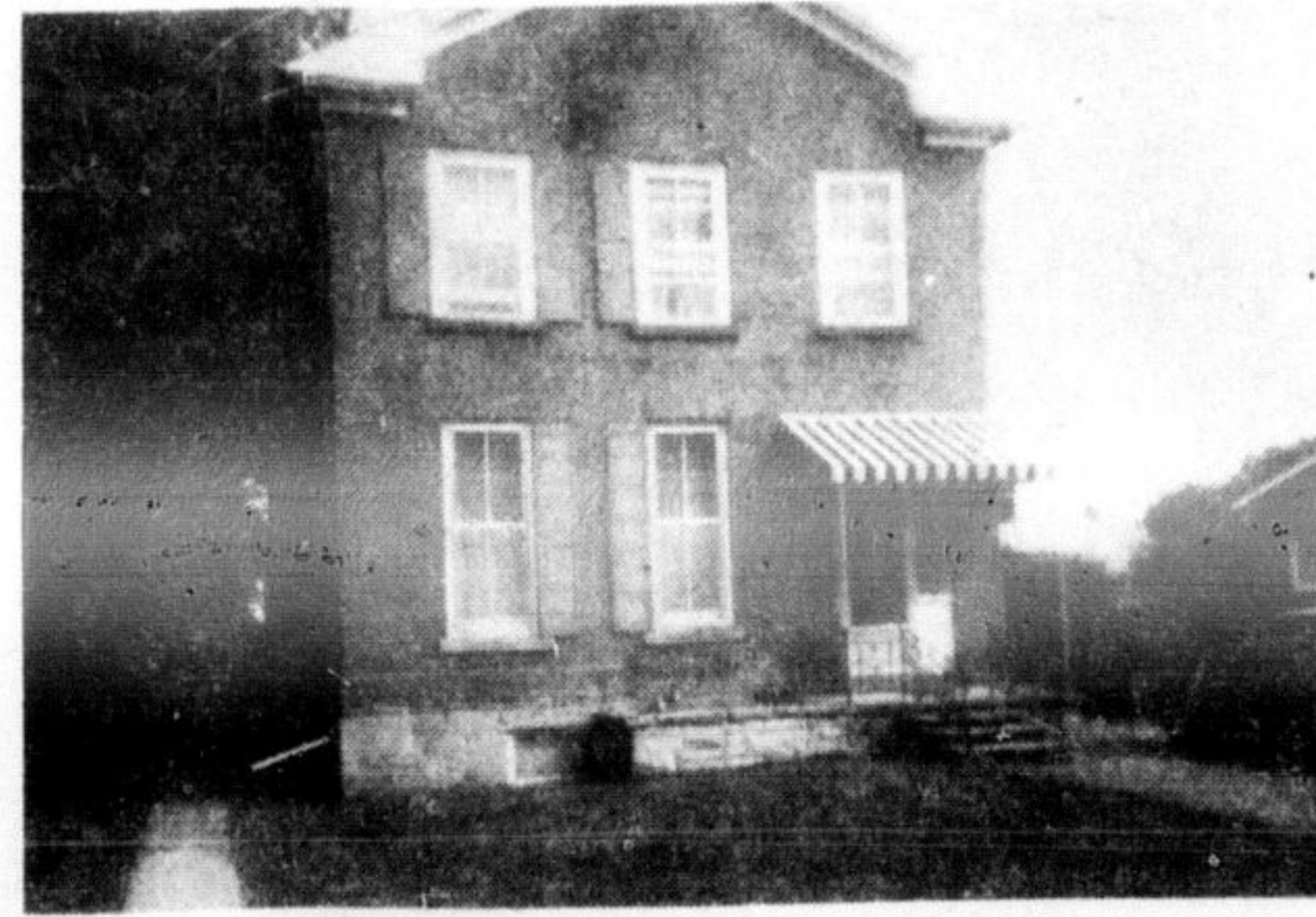

A horse drawn wagon featured the aspects of conservation covered by the Halton Region Conservation Authority from the Mountsberg Nature Centre to the familiar Kelso and Glen Eden ski area.

The prize-winning Kinsmen float featured Sesame Street with colorfully costumed characters and a float by the Halton TB and Respiratory Diseases Association reminding viewers of the importance of Christmas seals.

A float from the Milton District High School included a band playing Christmas music and vivacious antics by the school cheerleaders while the mounted Mustang, the school symbol, looked on. Santa's Workshop was the theme of the Milton Optimist float and Milton Marine and Sport showed examples of their summer and winter sports equipment.

A large crowd watched the parade as it passed Milton Plaza and people lined much of the remainder of the route.
