itself to promote the distribution of Bibles among elementary schools for classroom study. In view of Mr. Singleton's military attention to detail, his ignorance of the facts of this situation is rather appalling. But his public criticisms of Renaissance in this matter is mischievous and derogatory in its intent. If he were to inquire first before slanderously misrepresenting the work of a voluntary citizens' group, he would find the following to be the facts of the case:

1. That a trustee contacted Renaissance concerning requests received from high school teachers for a modern language version of the Bible;
2. That the trustee asked us for suggestions in this regard;
3. That we recommended "The Greatest is Love", the Living New Testament, published by The World Home Bible League;
4. That the trustee asked us if we might be interested in supplying the same for these teachers with the added suggestion that there might be others in the region who would also be interested in having them in their classrooms;
5. That through the generosity of an anonymous Renaissance member, we were able to supply freely the original request for about 50 copies and to offer to continue to make this publication available freely to other similar requests;
6. That the trustee agreed with the suggestion that a memo be sent to all the principals of the region informing them of this offer," the release points out.

These facts hardly substantiate the accusations against Renaissance implied by the Director's comments to the press that we were engaged in a sort of sinister back door bit of religious proselytizing in the schools!

"Renaissance sympathizes with the trustees over the problems which your Director of Education is causing you and the people in the region. While some have suggested that one solution would be for the trustees to make his resignation retroactive to last March, we would recommend a compassionate "leave of absence" be granted to the Director, to go into effect at once," Campbell said.

Grant to HRCA dam

A provincial grant for \$3,977.77—the final payment towards completion of the Scotch Block Dam and Reservoir—has been forwarded to Halton Region Conservation Authority, Halton East MPP Jim Snow announced this week.

The project is located in the Town of Halton Hills. The project involved the acquisition of considerable land and the construction of a dam about 45 feet high and 500 feet long across the Middle Branch of the Sixteen Mile Creek.
