

Milton Council briefs

During a regular meeting of Milton Council Dec. 16 council:

—Agreed to consider moving the Memorial Fountain Court in front of Town Hall across the street to a parkette where the fountain would enjoy more prominence. Council will consider sharing the cost with Mrs. E. James Costigan. The fountain is in memory of Mrs. Costigan's late husband who served as clerk in Milton from 1958 to 1964.

—Granted permission to the grade 12 ways and means committee to sell kleenex box holders. Funds are to be used to sponsor the grade 12 trip.

—Tabled a snowmobiling by-law until regional council deals with a similar by-law. Provincial legislation is also before the legislature dealing with snowmobiles.

Philharmonic trios to visit Halton schools

The Live Art Trio and Metamorphosis-3 are two trios which will visit Halton schools in the new year. Both groups have played with the Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra and their musicianship is enhanced by their ability to establish a warm rapport with young audiences.

Live Art is an exciting trio of piano, percussion and double bass; musical entertainment that always captures the entire attention of the audience. Live Art appearances range from performances with the Hamilton Philharmonic as artists-in-residence, to school and library concerts. They have been warmly received wherever they have appeared and have performed for the Wentworth County, Wellington, and Norfolk County Boards of Education for audiences from Kindergarten to Grade 13.
