THE BUBBLE-GUM SOUND

Does this form of music have a place in the rock scene? Originally, it was directly aimed at the pre-teen age group. Bubble-gum music, defined, is rock music in its simplest terms. The groups or artists who play this style shy away from any serious idioms of thought. They pin their ideas on sweet innocent love and on childhood fantasies.

Bubble-gum came into its own when Buddah Records was established in 1967. Such groups as: The 1910 Fruitgum Company (Hits "Simon Says, 1, 2, 3 Red Light and Indian Giver"); Ohio Express (Hits, "Yummy, Yummy, Chewy, Chewy and Mercy"); and the Cowsills (Hits, "Rain, the Park, and other Things, Indian Lake and Hair"), introduced the sound to the young record buyer.

Fads come and go. . .bubble-gum was called just that by most of the critics. Ten years later, this music is still filling a void in rock and making all kinds of money. Bobby Sherman (Hits "Little Women, La La La and Easy Come, Easy Go") Tommy Roe (Hits "Dizzy, Sweet Pea, Jam Up, Jelly Tight"); the Archies (Hits "Sugar, Sugar, Jingle, Jangle" and the Monkees (Hits "I'm a Believer, Daydream Beliver, Pleasant Valley Sunday"), followed bubble-gum into the

The 70s brought teen idols as bubble-gum heroes. The Partridge Family had their own show and David Cassidy was a superstar. (Hits "I Think I Love You, Woke Up in Love, Am I Losing You"). When the fad passed the Osmonds became the king-pins, featuring Donny Osmond ("Sweet and Innocent, One Bad Apple, Yo Yo, Go Away Little Girl").

Today, the Bay City Rollers are riding high as the leading bubble-gum band, with sold-out concerts, million selling records and causing the type of hysteria that the Beatles created over a decade ago. ("Saturday Night, Money Honey, Love Letter, Dedication").

Is there anything wrong with the pre-teens having their own music, with their own stars? Your comments are invited.

Focusing on: TOMMY JAMES AND THE SHONDELLS

Tommy James (singer, guitarist and song-writer), led his group the Shondells to hit after hit during the 1960s. This is the only bubble-gum band I listen to.

Their lyrics were easy to understand and the music they played was tangible. The group had one song that crossed the line of bubble-gum to an almost progressive sound in "Crimson in Clover". The record has exceeded sales of over 6.000,000

Their hits are "Hanky Panky, It's Only Love, I Think We're Alone Now, Mony Mony, Crimson in Clover, Mirage, Sweet Cherry Wine, Out of the Blue, Crystal Blue Persuasion, Ball of Fire, She Can't take it no More, Sugar on Sunday, Come to Me, Travelin' and Adrienne".

In 1970, the group split up when James went into seclusion for months. He was recovering from drug addiction. He succeeded in overcoming the 'monkey on the back' and had a successful solo career. Hits were "Draggin' the Line, I'm Coming Home, Love Song."

Record Care-Remember that the stylus tip (needle) does not last forever. Depending on the amount of use, it should be changed when needed.
