"We need a real demonstration of love in our Christian homes and churches today," Mrs. Ho told the mainly female gathering of 85 inside Knox Church. "If there was more love, there would be less controversy and strife in our lives."

Mrs. Ho said most of us know little of actually loving people — especially those who don't agree with us or whose personality rubs us the

wrong way. And sometimes, she noted, the person we find it difficult to get along with is not even an outsider.

"It may be a person who is close to us — maybe even a member of our own family,"

said, love doesn't just happen. It comes about gradually through effort and prayer.

Mrs. Ho said the definition of love found in the dictionary is only superficial and that the only complete definition of the word must include God because, she said, "God is disciplining.
