Chicken cut-ups

Chickens were studied at the third meeting of the Halton 4-H Veterinary Science club. A movie on chicken gizzards—the way they work and the sounds they make—started the meeting. Afterwards five chickens were opened.

Leader George Swann cut open the first one and showed the various parts. Diseases in the chickens were diagnosed and the symptoms were noted.

Then the members tried opening the remaining

chickens, followed by a quiz on naming 40 parts of the bird. Then another movie was shown, called "Wee Chick Life" which showed the formation of the embryo in the egg from the first day until the little chick cracks through the shell.

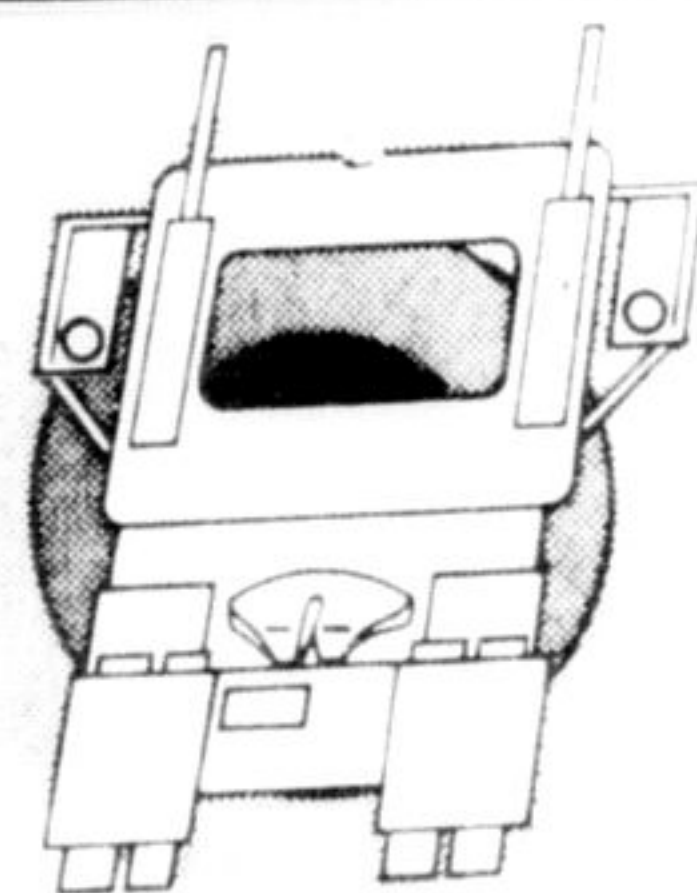
