## Burlington lawyer new Halton judge

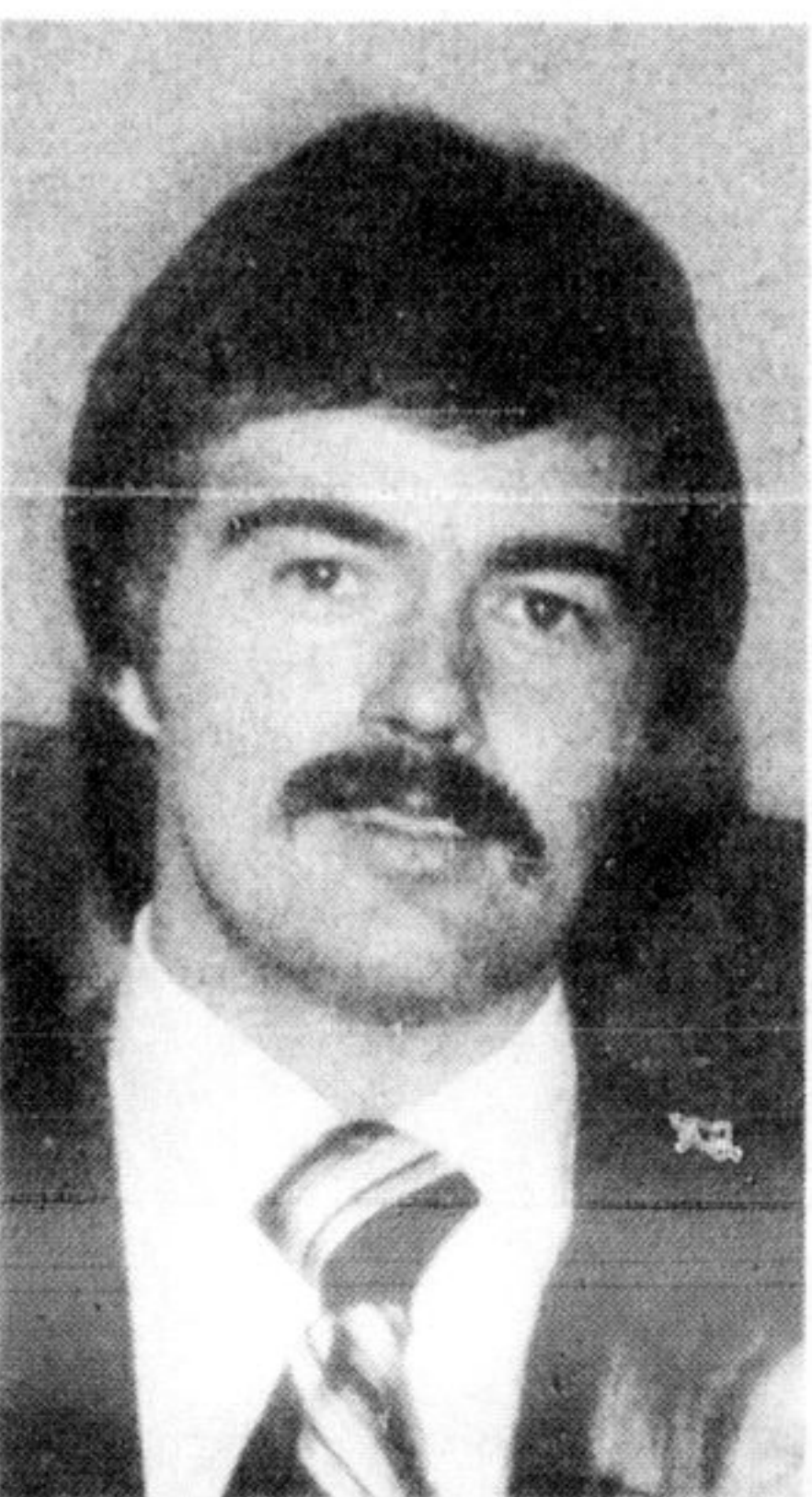
A growing caseload in Halton's criminal court has necessitated the addition of another full time judge and Thursday afternoon John E. C. Robinson of Burlington was sworn in to fill the new position.

He joins Judge Douglas Latimer and Judge William Sharpe on the bench for provincial court criminal cases. The fourth Halton Judge is James Fuller, who handles family court work. Crown Attorney James Treleven explained the caseload has been growing lately and Halton has been using the services of outside judges about four days a week for the past year. Judge Robinson's appointment gives Halton three men full time for criminal work and relieves the travelling judges for work in other regions.

Chief Judge Fred Hayes of provincial court administered the oath of office to Judge Robinson in a brief ceremony at the provincial court house in Milton Thursday. Assisting on the bench was Judge of the County and Surrogate Court for Halton, Judge Alan B. Sprague.

Judge William Sharpe assisted the new judge in donning the red-ribbed robe that denotes a provincial court judge. A gallery of other judges from courts in surrounding counties and regions looked on. Among them was Halton's retired judge Kenneth M. Langdon of Georgetown.

The crown attorney and Peter Heslin, representing the Halton Law Association, congratulated Judge Robinson on his appointment

and welcomed him to the bench.

In a brief speech full of humor, Judge Robinson thanked those who have helped him prepare for the work and mentioned his family, including his mother, mother-in-law, wife, two daughters and son who were in the audience. "I trust our association will be friendly and rewarding in the future," he told the Law Association.

"I am fully aware of the trust that has been placed in me," he said, and expressed the hope he will be able to carry out his judicial duties with dignity, humanity,

understanding and compassion.

Judge Hayes urged the new judge to "balance the needs of the person (on trial) against the needs of the community," and said he knew Judge Robinson would dispense justice "with an even hand, a sense of responsibility and experience—as a lawyer and as a man."

Judge Robinson's late father, John E. Robinson was a magistrate in Hamilton for about 10 years. For the past two years Judge Robinson has been a member of the Ontario Labor Relations

Board. Prior to that he practiced as a lawyer in Hamilton, with two firms, including a stint of criminal court work. He was educated at McMaster University and graduated from Osgoode Hall in 1965. He is 47.

The judge and his family attend Aldershot Presbyterian Church and the minister of that church, the Rev. David Nicholson was on hand Thursday to give a brief benediction at the conclusion of the swearing-in ceremony. Mr. Nicholson is a former minister of St. David's Presbyterian Church in Campbellville.
