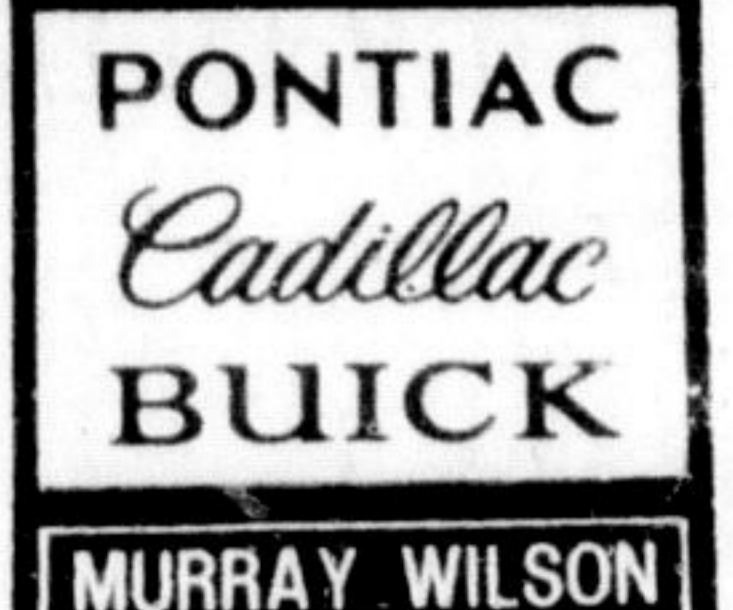

Medical science can prevent disability in about four out of five patients suffering even the most severe forms of arthritis. Thousands of patients receive excellent care sufficient to control their arthritis, but thousands of other patients still share the devastating results of un-solved problems, they pointed out.

Among your associates, family and friends you will invariably find someone affected by arthritis. More than one million Canadians suffer from arthritis. It affects people of all ages and all walks of life. About 400,000 are disabled to some degree, tens of thousands being confined to bed and wheelchairs.

Arthritis is a term describing about 100 different diseases. Most have but one feature in common—the inflammation of joints. It includes many diseases which attack the supporting or connective tissues, not only in the joints but elsewhere in the body, the heart, kidney, lungs and eyes.

Medical knowledge is now sufficient to control inflammation and prevent serious disability in the majority of arthritis patients. Yet throughout Canada disability remains widespread. Many family doctors have not been taught to recognize arthritis in its early stages or to treat it effectively. There are fewer than half the number of specialists required to meet the needs of family doctors and their patients.

Even more important, medicine does not yet know the underlying causes of the inflammation which leads to joint destruction. If family doctors had the required skills and if there were enough arthritis specialists, it would be possible to make good care available to all. Yet unless further knowledge is gained through research, most arthritis will require a lifetime of treatment simply to prevent disability. Others for whom disability cannot now be prevented will find their lives ruined by relentless and intractable disease.

The highlight of 1976 for the Arthritis Society was the completion of the last Rheumatic Disease Unit at Laval University which means that all medical schools across Canada have one Rheumatic Disease Units are the main mechanisms through which rheumatologists are trained, research is pursued and most family doctors receive their rheumatological instruction.
