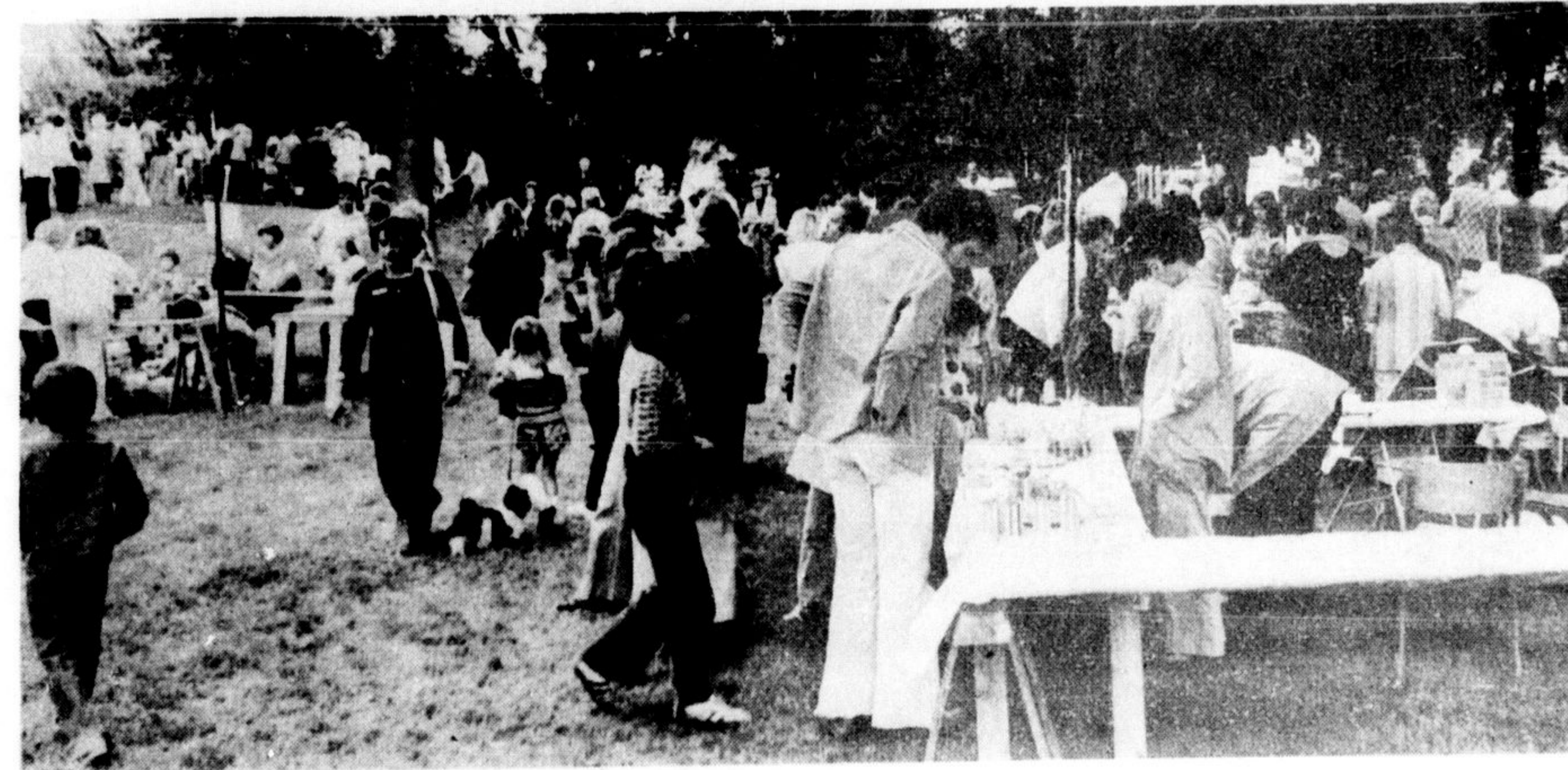

# Honor Harvey Prudham for service

Rev. G. Rivers of Nelson and Palermo circuit was guest speaker at the annual memorial service at Bethel Chapel, North Burlington on Sept. 4. This little Canadian Wesleyan church was built in 1853 by settlers in the area who were not only builders of the early church, but their loyalty and determination to establish new homes and a future for their families in what was then a wilderness, did much to lay the foundation for our rich Canadian Heritage.

Mrs. Lorraine Swallow of Lowville sang two appropriate numbers, "I need no Other Monument" and "Lord Most Holy". Miss Jean Wilkinson of Cedar Springs Rd. presided at the organ.

Following the service Ron Coverdale presented an oil painting to Harvey Prudham on behalf of the church Board, in recognition of his 31 years as secretary-treasurer. Mr. Prudham is one of the

fourth generation of his family and recently gave land to enlarge the church grounds which are located on the north corner of the Prudham homestead on Britannia Rd.

Mrs. Gordon Coverdale, well known artist in the area, painted the picture for the presentation.

The church has been beautifully restored as a pioneer landmark and young people are using it as a historic setting for weddings.

The original seats have been restored and the unique pulpit is quite similar in design to the historical Hay Bay church pulpit at Picton, Ontario, which is said to be the oldest existing church edifice in existence.

The church was filled with worshippers from Toronto, Hamilton, Owen Sound and many local centers.
