### Town budget up 7-8 per cent

budget committee, reduced the 1978 operating budget for the town by approximately \$220,000 at a meeting last

Council earlier reduced estimates by \$300,000 and the most recent cuts bring the budget down to approximately \$4,300,000.

Most recent cuts see the construction of storm sewers on Main St. East deferred until next year at a saving of \$200,000. Council asked the Recreation Parks and Department departmental estimates by a further \$5,000 and asked the Library Board to reduce the library budget by a total of

Treasurer Don Lougheed said the town budget will be up by seven or eight per cent over last year.

The setting of a mill rate won't be done until after the Halton Board of Education and Halton Regional Council have finalized those budgets

preservation philosophy to one of development, we must be prepared to supply such safeguards as would be expected from any developer," he said.


#### Barely a quorum
