
While all three feel confident of victory some polls are indicating that as many as 90 per cent of the delegates haven't yet made a decision.


The number of registered delegates is so high that organizers are concerned that Blakelock High School might not be large enough to accommodate the meeting.


"Really to predict who is coming first, second and third isn't logical and I don't think psycological warfare will do any good," Dr. Ross said.


