Credit Union to open branch in Georgetown

A location is yet to be decided, but plans are underway for a new branch office of Halton Community Credit Union Ltd. in Georgetown. The announcement during the Credit Union's annual meeting Saturday evening at Roma Hall, Milton comes after a wait of three years to set up business in Georgetown. The new branch office will offer all services presently available in Milton and Oakville, said Manager Jules Fryters. There are no other community credit unions in Georgetown, he said, adding the new branch expects to acquire a lot of new members as well as approximately 150 Georgetown members now doing business at one of two Milton branches. "We saw the potential in Georgetown as great, or even larger than that of Milton," he stated. "We expect at least 3,000 members during the next two to three years." Halton Community Credit Union now has a membership of 5,500 in Milton and Oakville. The Credit Union has so far been unsuccessful in acquiring land for the proposed 1,500 square foot building. Mr. Fryters attributes part of the problem to opposition from other banking institutions. "It is still a matter of deciding whether we will locate in the north, south or downtown districts, but we are having objections from every part," he said. The Georgetown branch is expected to be opened with a staff of three within three months of acquiring a site, said Mr. Fryters.

Credit Union finances show healthy increase

Halton Community Credit Union is strong and healthy and the future looks bright, Ben Reis, president of the Credit Union told members at the annual meeting Saturday evening. Financial statements presented at the meeting showed an increase of \$2 million in assets in 1977. "That figure represents the amount accumulated in the first 14 years of the Credit Union," added Jules Fryters, general manager. Term deposits by members totalled over \$3 million, showing a 47.3 per cent increase over the previous year's figures, with total assets at \$11,549,782, a 31.2 per cent increase over 1976. "People are getting more rate conscious, explained Mr. Fryters following the meeting. He further attributed free chequing accounts, competitive interest rates and attractive loan services to the increased business. With approximately 5,500 members at the three Credit Union offices, Mr. Fryters predicts significant growth within the coming year. "I think 1978 is going to be an even bigger year than 1977," he stated, adding that a new mortgage rate policy introduced in November 1977 will attract many new customers. The policy sets loan rates to the Bank of Canada prime

According to Mr. Fryters, the purpose of the by-law is to allow the Credit Union to buy real estate for office purposes without going through the procedure of having a meeting with members to make a decision. He stated such meetings frequently become public knowledge and tend to increase the price of property as soon as the seller is aware the buyer is a financial institution. New by-laws also included a redefinition of permissible loan limits, a redefinition of the Bond of Association and the right of the Board of Directors to borrow on behalf of the Credit Union. Three positions on the Board of Directors were filled by C. H. Stiehl, Gus Tielmans, and Sam Hokansson.

Credit U presents plans

Plans for a \$250,000 addition to the Halton Community Credit Union offices on Main St., Milton were presented during the Credit Union's annual meeting Saturday evening at Roma Hall, Milton. "The preliminary work is completed and we will call tenders within the month," President Ben Reis told members. The 3,800 square foot addition to the present building was announced earlier by Jules Fryters, general manager. Work is expected to start by May with completion date set for September. The new office space will mean more room for all departments, said Mr. Reis, and in addition, a second floor will be built. The building was first constructed in 1969, measuring 30 by 60 feet. An official opening will be held in October to celebrate the 20th anniversary of Halton Community Credit Union.
