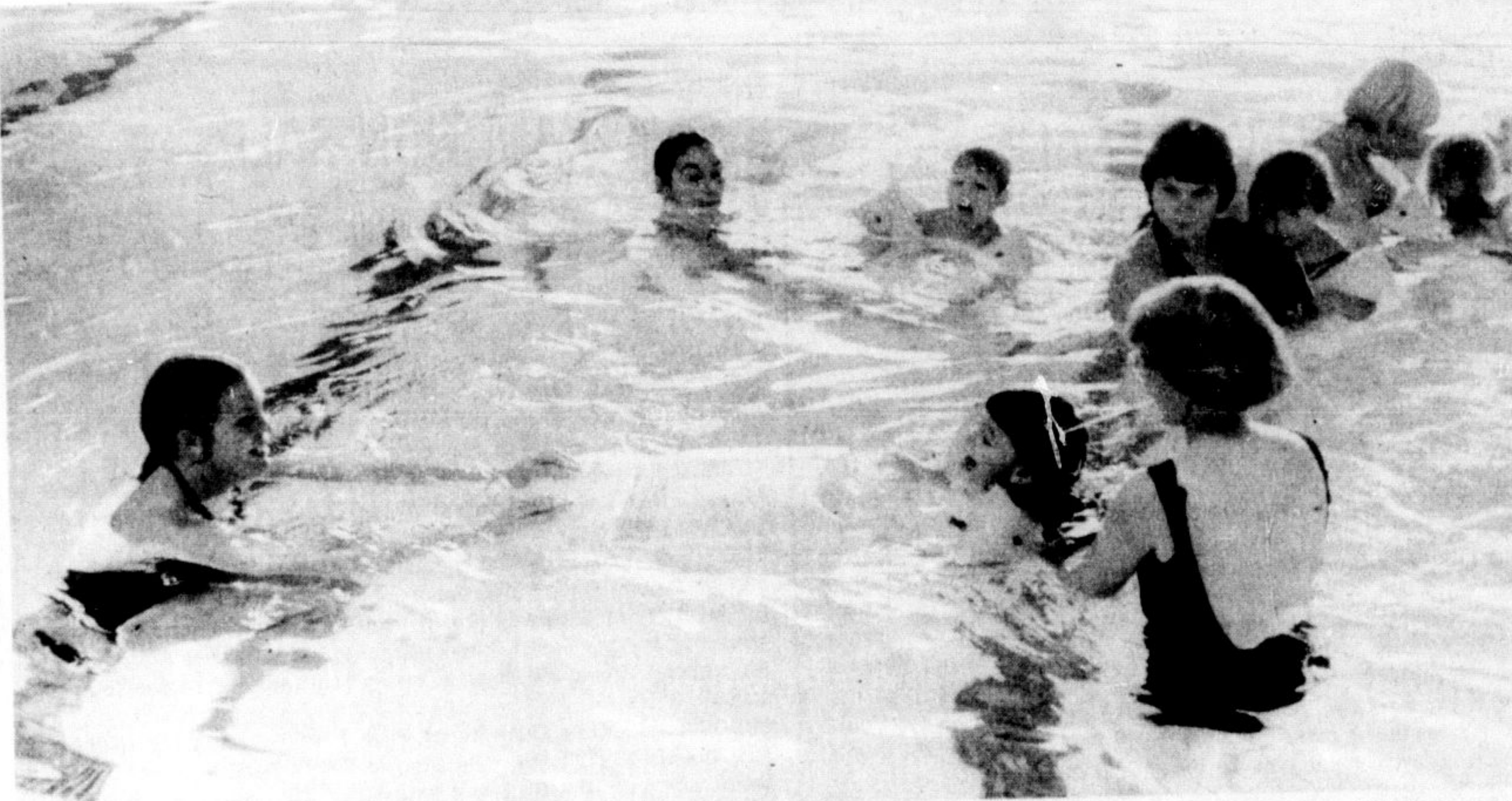

No way police hdqtrs. in Milton

A statement by Halton Police Civilian Administrator Ray Munro that he had seen a document suggesting police headquarters be relocated in Milton, took Halton Region Police Commission by surprise, Thursday.

"That's news to me, there never has been any idea of moving the headquarters so far away. It's ludicrous," stated Acting chairman Harry Barrett.

The statement came up when a letter from the Property Management department of Halton Region stated Milton Health Unit may be offered to the police as a facility. Munro said if this is possible he would withdraw his request for repairs to the Milton police building.

Barrett claimed the Health Unit building would need a lot of repair. "If we take over that building we're taking over a dog," commented Barrett.

Commission member Glenn Magnuson contended an overall study of police housing needs over the long term should be done, rather than on a piece-meal basis.

Commission member Dave Coons agreed with Magnuson's suggestion and said it should have been done six months ago.

The commission decided no more work should be done on the Milton precinct, until a study of all housing needs for police is completed.
