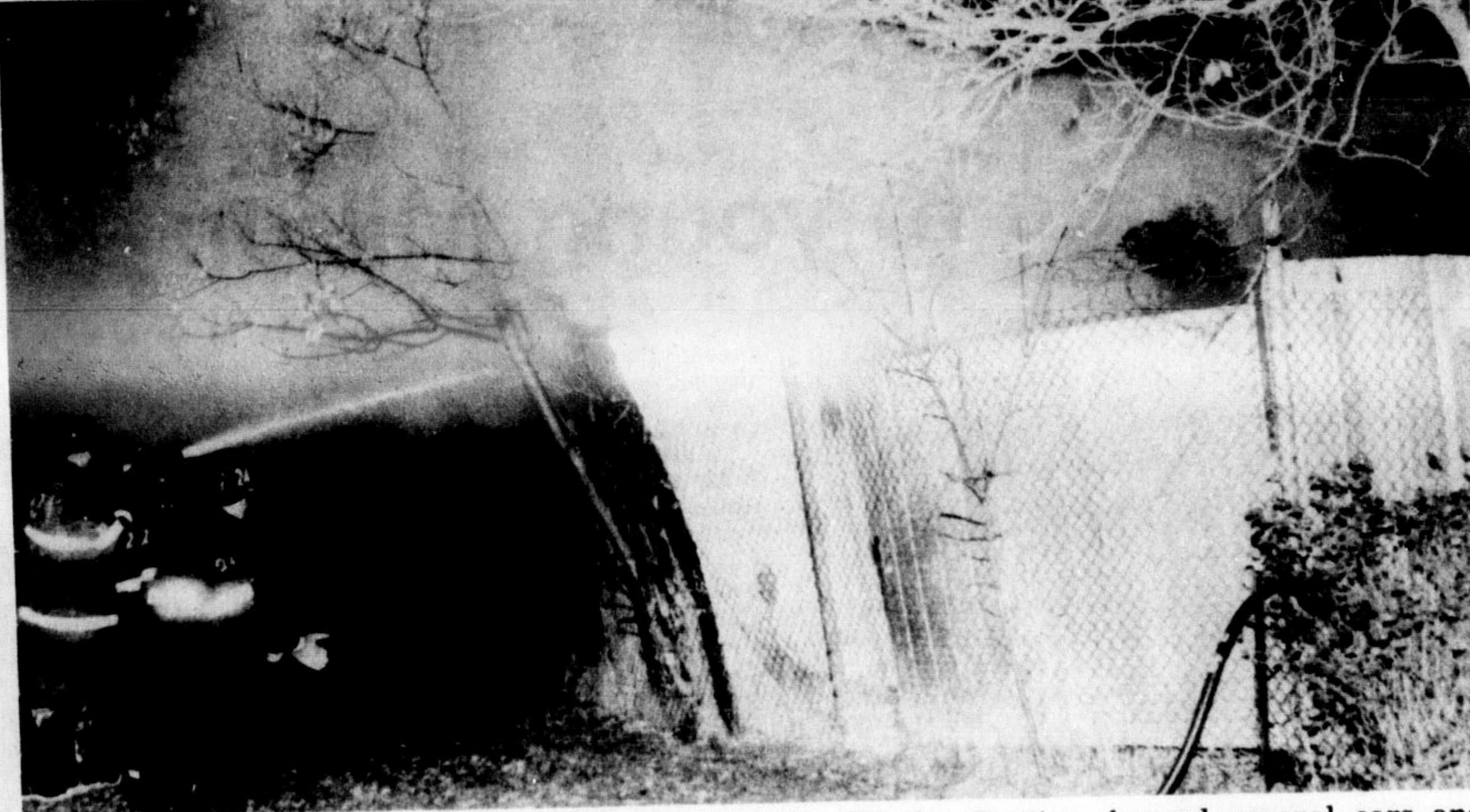

\$3,000 damage in house fire

An estimated \$3,000 damage was caused Tuesday morning to a local home, after attempts to thaw a hot water pipe resulted in a fire, according to Halton Regional Police.

Archie Metcalfe of 93 Hugh St. was warming the water pipes in the back shed of his home with a blow torch, when a section of the wall caught fire.

The shed is located behind the kitchen and within minutes, fire had spread through the insulation into the upper floor of the Metcalfe home.

According to police, the home suffered extensive smoke damage.
