Last week, in a major confrontation in the Legislature, the Liberal and New Democratic Parties threatened to vote together to reduce the Ministry of Housing's spending by \$18,000—an amount equal to the extra salary paid to the Minister. The Government House Leader warned that such a move could be considered a vote of non-confidence. Subsequently the government backed off just far enough on the controversial Contrakon development on the Niagara Escarpment to avoid possible defeat on this matter. The Housing Minister said he will arrange meetings between Contrakon and local ratepayers opposed to the development.

Meanwhile, the project's architect has indicated that the company would be willing to settle on another location if it is within an hour's drive of the airport and offers an equally spectacular view. Subsequently, landowners on the Niagara Escarpment and in other areas of Ontario have offered to sell their land for the controversial Contrakon Ltd. project. The Housing Minister has indicated that he has received more than a dozen offers from landowners wishing to sell their property for the \$16-million hotel and conference centre. He stated that he told the people concerned to put their offers in writing. The councillor at the Huronia Regional Centre in Orillia who was reinstated after being fired for and later convicted of kicking a mentally retarded woman in the face has been transferred from the Ministry of Community and Social Services to a position in another ministry. The new job ensures that he will no longer have direct contact with residents in any provincially-run institution. In a toughly negotiated settlement between the Ontario Public Service Employees Union and the Provincial Government, the councillor was transferred to the Ministry of Government Services where he will work as a supply clerk at the same pay he was receiving as a residential councillor at Huronia. Fire calls decrease

The number of fires in the first 10 months of 1978 is down from the same period in 1977, according to Milton Fire Chief Jim Coulson. There were 217 fires in Milton as of Oct. 31, 1977, compared with 199 fires as of Oct. 31, 1978... a decrease of 18 fires. There was a marked increase in fire calls over the 1976 period, though. In that period, there was approximately half the number of fire calls (108) as there were in the two subsequent years. Chief Coulson said the severity of fires has not increased all that much over the years, but that the frequency of the small fires is up over 1976.
