



Drury students learn art as artist visits school



STUDENTS AT E.C. Drury School for the Hearing Handicapped received a lesson in visual arts, courtesy of the Ontario Arts Council and the Ministry of Education. Freelance artist Michael Banger spent two weeks with the students, and their creations were quite impressive, including a pyramid, seen at left with Mr. Banger standing, Kari Matson in front, and David Herman kneeling. Above, Laura Cooper and Glen Stubbart experience the feel of dried leaves in an association experiment in which an example of a characteristic (i.e., something black) is posted on the blackboard, and strings lead from it to something else which is also black. Other examples of the students' artwork has been hung around the school, such as vaseline self-portraits, wings, streamers, and other multi-characteristic work. The project of sponsoring an artist to work in the school is co-funded by the school and the Arts Council.

All six winners had earlier been named winners in local contests sponsored by the fire departments in Acton, Georgetown, Milton, Burlington and Oakville. Local winners went on to the regional competition and Brampton Fire Department's fire prevention officer did the final judging.


