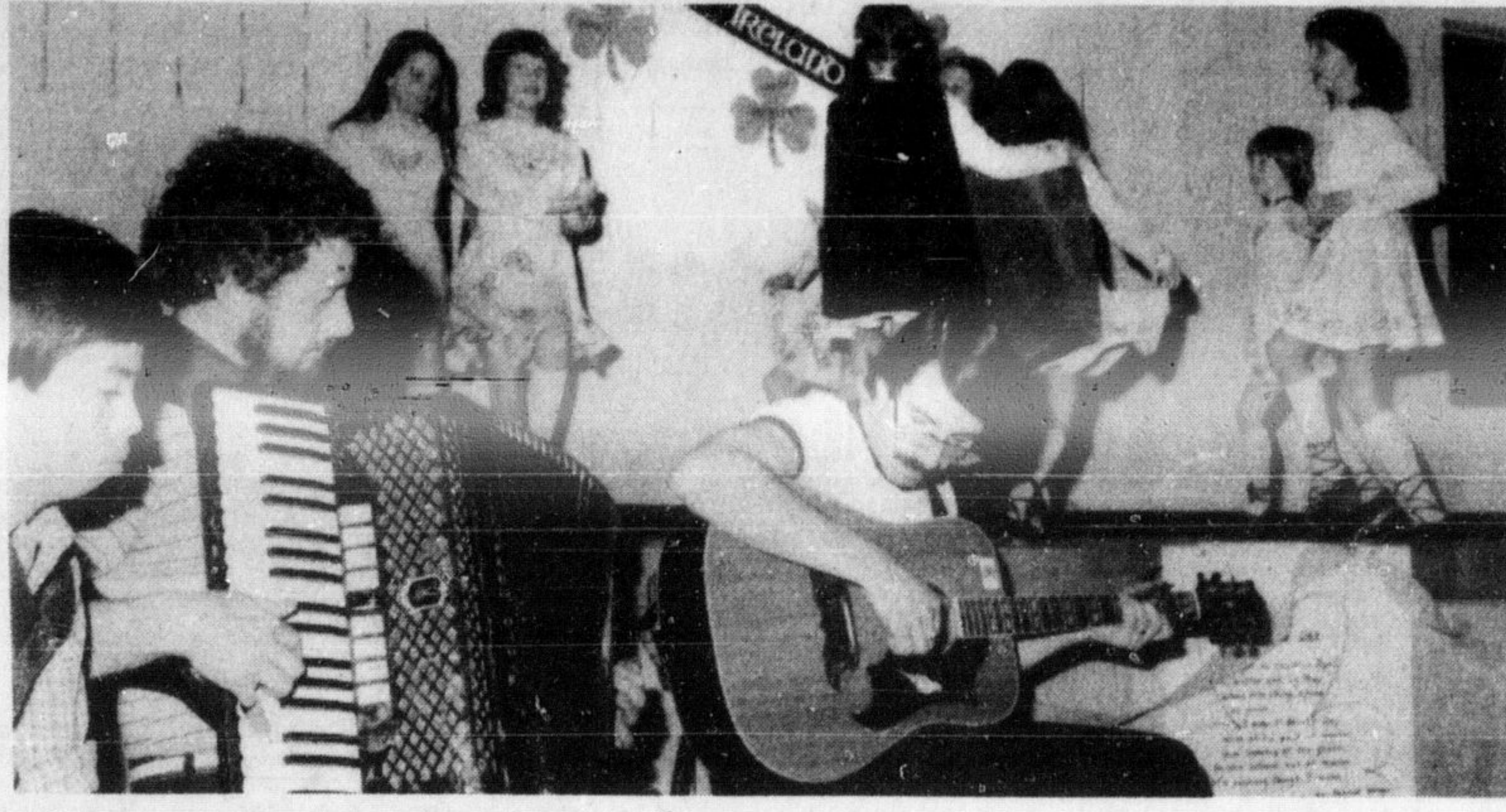

Patrick visits St. Pete

With a man named Kevin Finnegan as principal, it would be only natural to expect St. Peter's Separate School in Milton to celebrate St. Patrick's Day. Celebrate it they did. Friday afternoon saw a rollicking good time as the students of the school wound down to their winter break in fine Irish style. Principal Finnegan enlisted the aid of Doug Card, a grade seven teacher at Holy Rosary School and Mike Robinet, librarian at both Holy Rosary and St. Peter's Schools, to join him in providing an afternoon of music and fun. Mr. Finnegan played the accordion and guitar, and sang Irish songs with the group. In addition to the Irish jigs and reels, the students saw some Irish dancing performed by students of a local dance school run by Mr. Finnegan's wife. Most of the students doing the dancing were from Holy Rosary or St. Peter's, said Mr. Finnegan. Mr. Finnegan said the Irish music was mingled with Canadian folk songs from Quebec, Newfoundland and Nova Scotia. He said the songs were all "interrelated". "The kids should appreciate the heritage we have and how it is related with other heritages in other lands. That's why we put on this show."
