# We're Tri-County champs beat Georgetown Sunday

Tri-County Championships don't come easy to a "A" rated team competing with "AA" and "AAA" centres.

But Milton's minor atom Docs and Dents claimed the title Sunday 3-2 in Georgetown and returned to Milton Memorial Arena sporting the shiny hardware for all the minor hockey fans there to see.

After eliminating Flamborough Sabres and Chinguacousy, Docs and Dents came up with a flat performance losing the

opening game to Georgetown 6-1.

But fighting back, the locals won the second game 4-3 on home ice and edged the red shirts 2-1 in the third contest. Georgetown won game four to even the best-of-five series.

In the championships game Wayne Rivers opened the scoring 3:47 into the first period on a pass from Stuart Thorne. Georgetown tied the tally 1-1 in the middle frame but the locals netted two in the third.

Travis Cole notched the

first from Robbie Wilson and the goal which proved to be the winner, was netted by Doug Drennan, unassisted with 3:21 to play.

Georgetown came flying back and scored with 2:33 remaining but Milton hung on to win.

Milton goaltenders Dave Dillon and Blair Leonard responded to the forwards' performance with several spectacular saves and were cited as the stars by coaches Ken Thompson, Peter Crawford and manager Dave Smith.

In Milton's first victory to even the series, Drennan scored twice and Thorne and Wilson added singles with assists going to Scott Ellwood, Cole, Pat Butler and Thorne.

The opening game loss featured back checking of Jason Newby, Scott Hillson and Cole.

The third contest offered witnesses excellent goaltending by both teams, particularly Miltons.

Scoring was led by Cole unassisted and Andrew Wilson potted the winning marker. Wilson's goal was on a long shot from the blueline with Drennan assisting.

Georgetown scored with 52 seconds remaining.

The defence of Brett Gervais, Justin Varga, and Wilson were instrumental in keeping Georgetown off the scoreboard. Also noted is the checking of Geoff Pollen and Drennan.

The fourth game which Georgetown used to even the series in Milton Saturday was taken in overtime. Wilson, Hillson and Pollen's pair completed Milton's scoring with Drennan and Wilson assisting.
