For the groom, a stag gathering was held by Murray Bullock, Rick Bridgman, Tom Cheeseman, Henry Nadalin and Terry Nova.

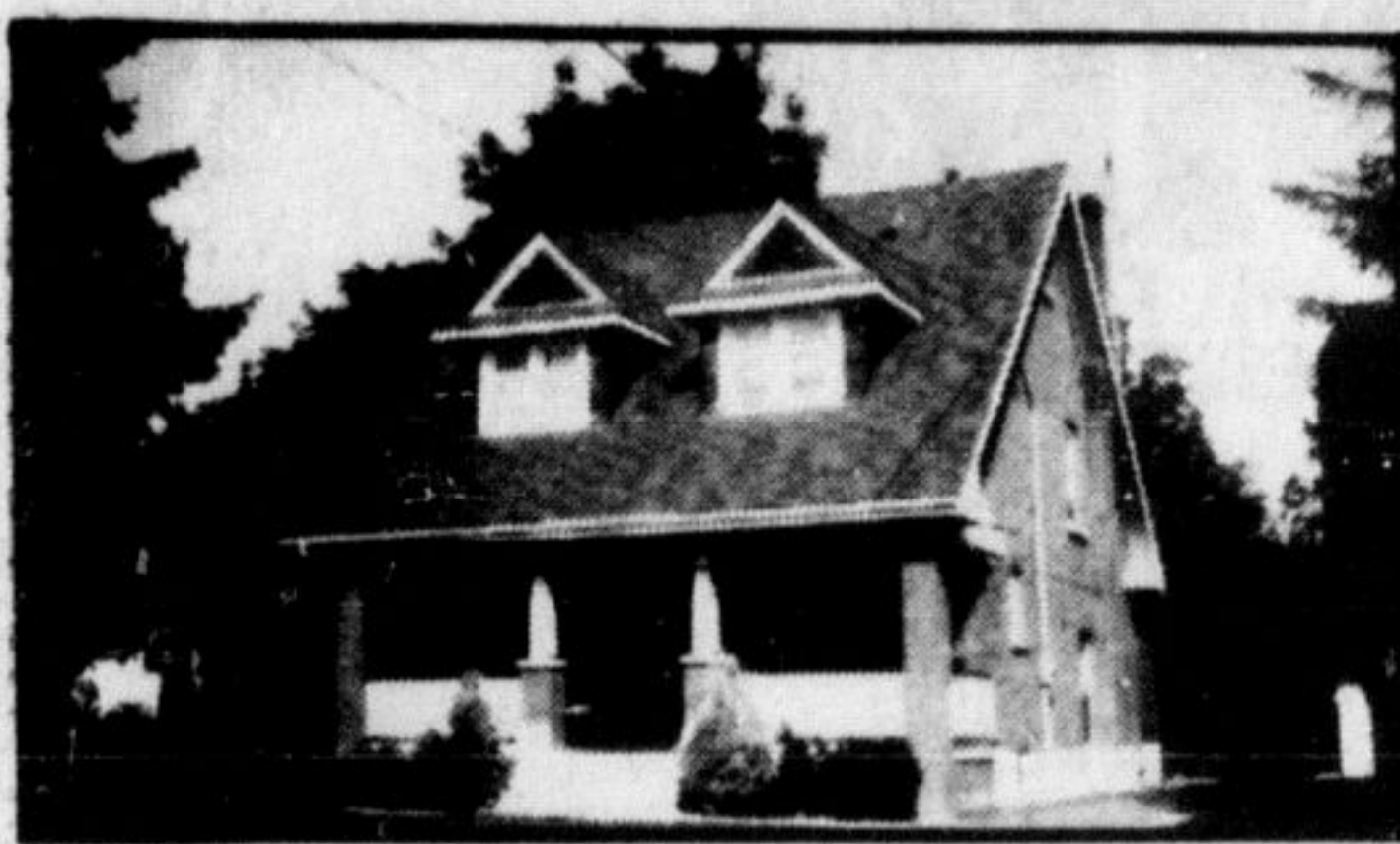
The newlyweds spent their honeymoon in Banff before returning to take up residence in Milton.
