ANY PERSON INTERESTED MAY, within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail, or deliver to the Clerk of The Town of Milton, notice of objection to approval of the said by-law or part thereof giving details of all or the portion of the by-law to which you object and detailed reasons therefor, and shall indicate that if a hearing is held the objector or an agent will attend at the hearing to support the objection.

ANY PERSON wishing to support the application for approval of the by-law may within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this notice send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of The Town of Milton notice of his support of approval of the said by-law together with a request for notice of any hearing that may be held giving also the name and address to which such notice should be given.

THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD may approve of the said by-law but before doing so it may appoint a time and place when any objection to the by-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing that may be held will be given only to persons who have filed an objection or notice of support and who have left with or delivered to the Clerk undersigned the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent and, similarly, to any person who has filed a request for a change in the provisions of the by-law.

BY-LAW NO. 74-79 Being a By-Law to amend Zoning By-law No. 11-67, as amended, being a Restricted Area By-law of the Former Township of Nassagaweya now in the Town of Milton.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Milton deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 11-67, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Milton enacts as follows:-

1. That Section 6.A.1.1. (Rural Residential Zone) of By-law Financing arranged on resid-No. 11-67 as amended, is hereby further amended by adding ential. after the words "dwelling unit" wherever it appears in the cottages. section the words "occupied by one family", so that with this amendment, the provision shall now read as follows: "Permitted uses:

A dwelling unit occupied by one family or a dwelling unit occupied by one family that incorporates the office of a doctor or dentist or similar professional person and uses accessory to the foregoing."

2. That Section 6.A.1.2.1 (Rural Residential Zone) of By-law No. 11-67 as amended, is hereby further amended by adding after the words "For a Dwelling Unit", the words "occupied by one family" so that with this amendment, the provision shall now read as follows:

"For a Dwelling Unit occupied by one family." 3. That all other provisions of By-law No. 11-67 as amended, with the exception of the aforesaid, shall continue to apply.

4. This By-law shall become effective on the date hereof subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board. READ a FIRST, SECOND, and THIRD TIME, and FINALLY PASSED, this 13th DAY OF August, 1979.


