People expect to get real fancy expensive things but if you make gifts it comes right from your heart, but sometimes people think that what you made isn't very nice and they end-up

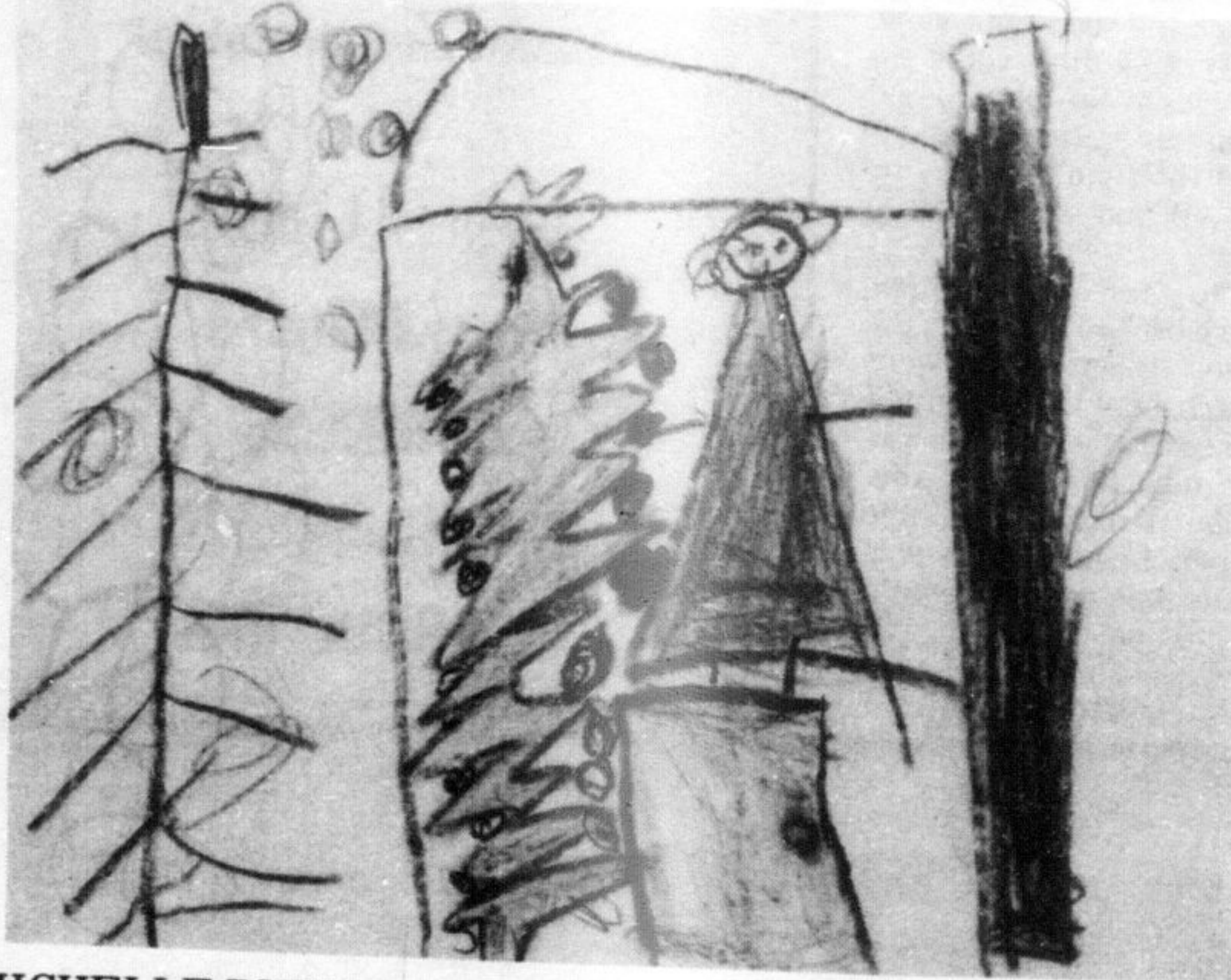
throwing it out. I guess they just don't realize the true meaning of Christmas.
