Little to hold up move

There appears to be little standing in the way of a Milton car dealer moving his operation. Murray Wilson, owner of the Cadillac, Pontiac, Buick dealership bearing his name appeared before Council's Committee of the Whole last Monday to discuss the rezoning of a parcel of land on the north side of Main St. Mr. Wilson wants to move his automobile dealership there from its current location on Main St. west of Highway 25. One of the objections to his plan for developing the land was put forward by Planning Director Bob Zsadamji who felt a six-foot fence should be erected at the back of the property for the privacy of homeowners abutting the land. Mr. Wilson said he would put the fence in and that it should have been shown on the plan he submitted to the town. Councillor Bill Johnson said he wanted all neighbors in the area to be notified of the intended zoning change being sought by Mr. Wilson. In addition, Mr. Wilson said he will look at expanding the lighting system on the property to avoid the type of vandalism suffered earlier this year at Gallinger Motors.

Rates up

Regional Council has changed the rates paid in the laundry room at Halton Centennial Manor. From now on, the rate charged to E.C. Drury School to process its laundry in the Manor will be increased by 2 cents per pound. Regional Council has also upped the fee it charges for day care service. The old rate was \$1.25 per diem, but this will increase to \$1.40 per diem effective May 1 and will stay in effect until Dec. 31.

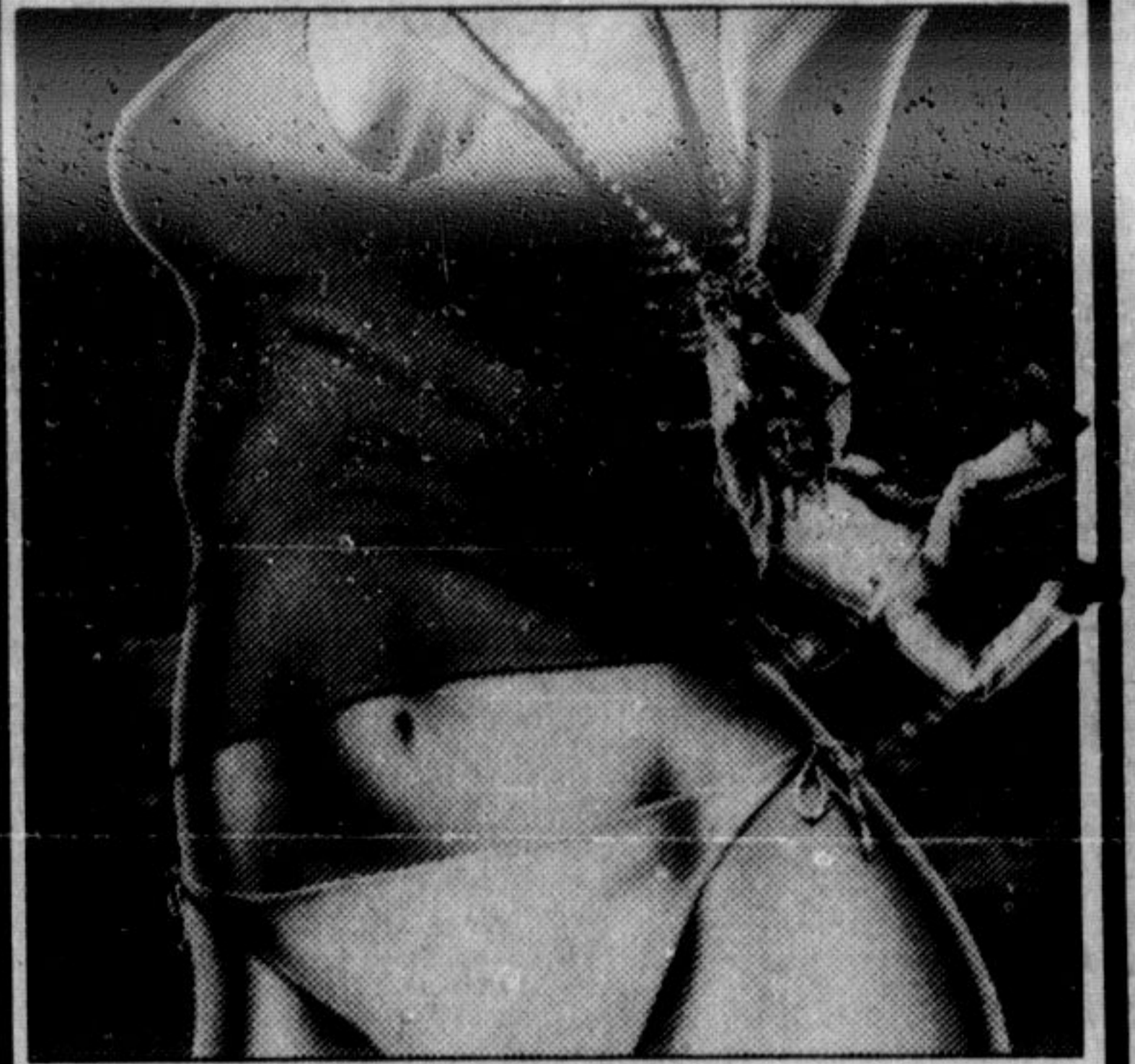

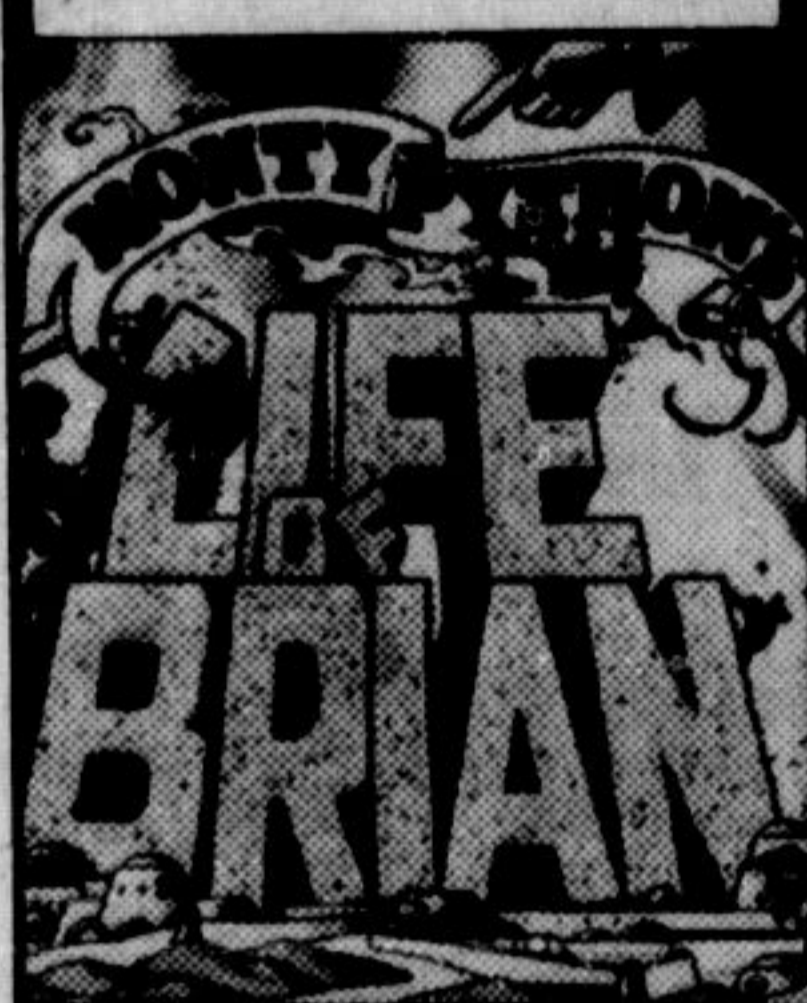
