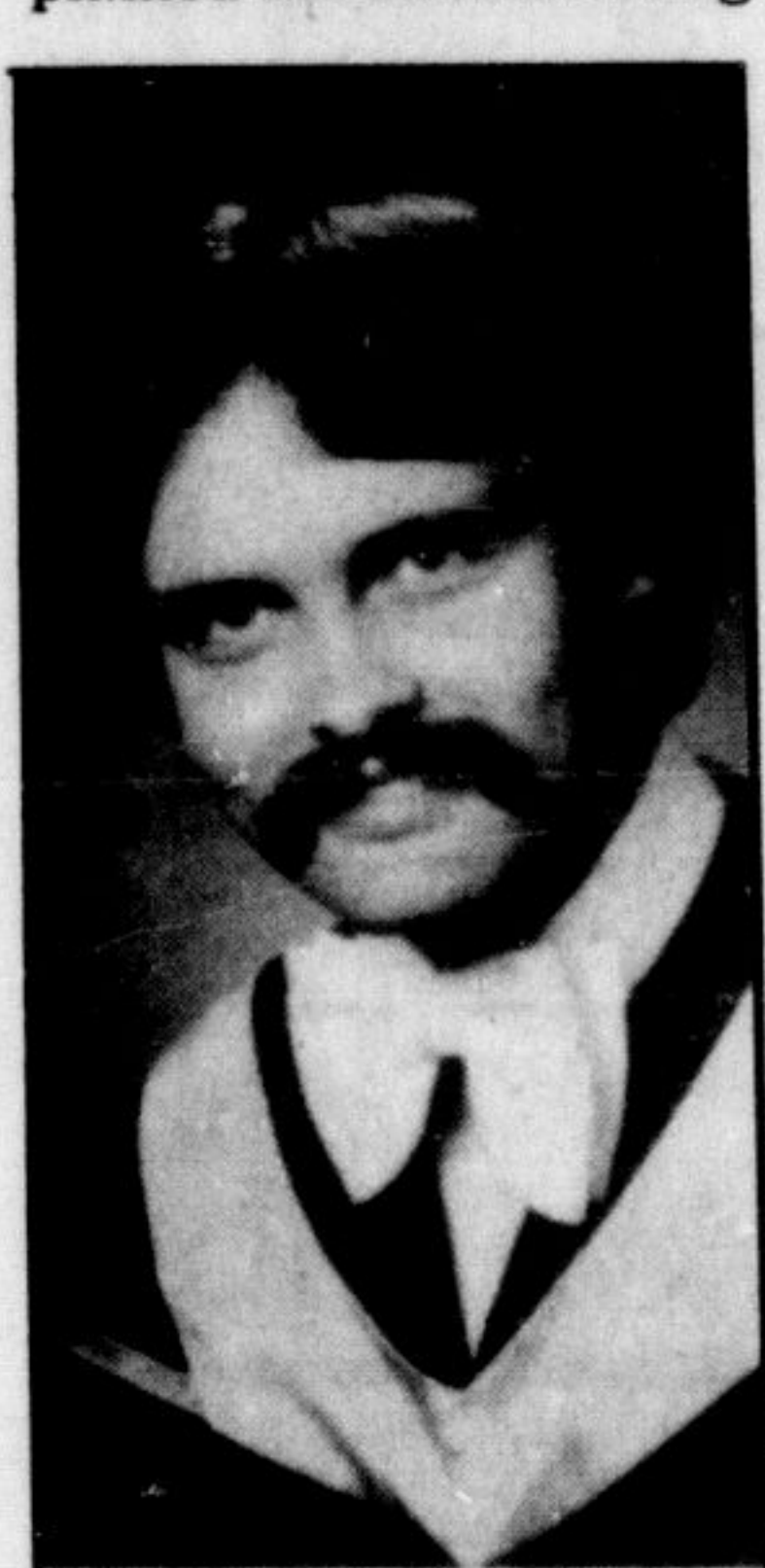


It's not perfect but . . .

was to represent the Canadian company, the American flag stood for the American-built cars it sells, and the flag of France represented the Renault line which was recently added.

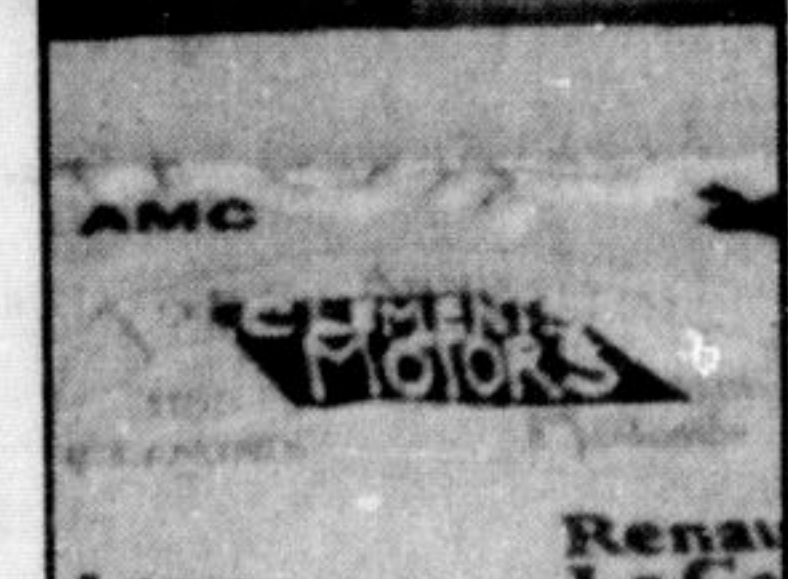
Clements Motors began May 13, 1955 as Allan Clements and Son (George is the son). Allan Clements semi-retired in 1972 and George took over operation of the firm.

Another 25-year employee is Vi Doherty, daughter of Allan and sister of George, who is the company's book-keeper.

The firm began as a Nash car dealership and also handled Allis Chalmers farm equipment. It expanded in 1976 with a large addition to the service department.

The cars have changed a lot in 25 years, George Clements recalls. He began with Nash, which became Rambler in 1957, then American Motors (AMC) in 1969. He figures he has sold over 5,000 cars in the 25 years in business.

Clements Motors has handled Sunoco products for all 25 years. The Jeep line was added in 1973. A special anniversary cake, made by George's



wife, recognized the AMC, Jeep, Renault and Sunoco names. A large crowd attended the open house and participated in free contests, guessing the number of balloons in a special edition Spirit, and guessing the age of an antique car parked in the front yard. A free service check was also offered.
