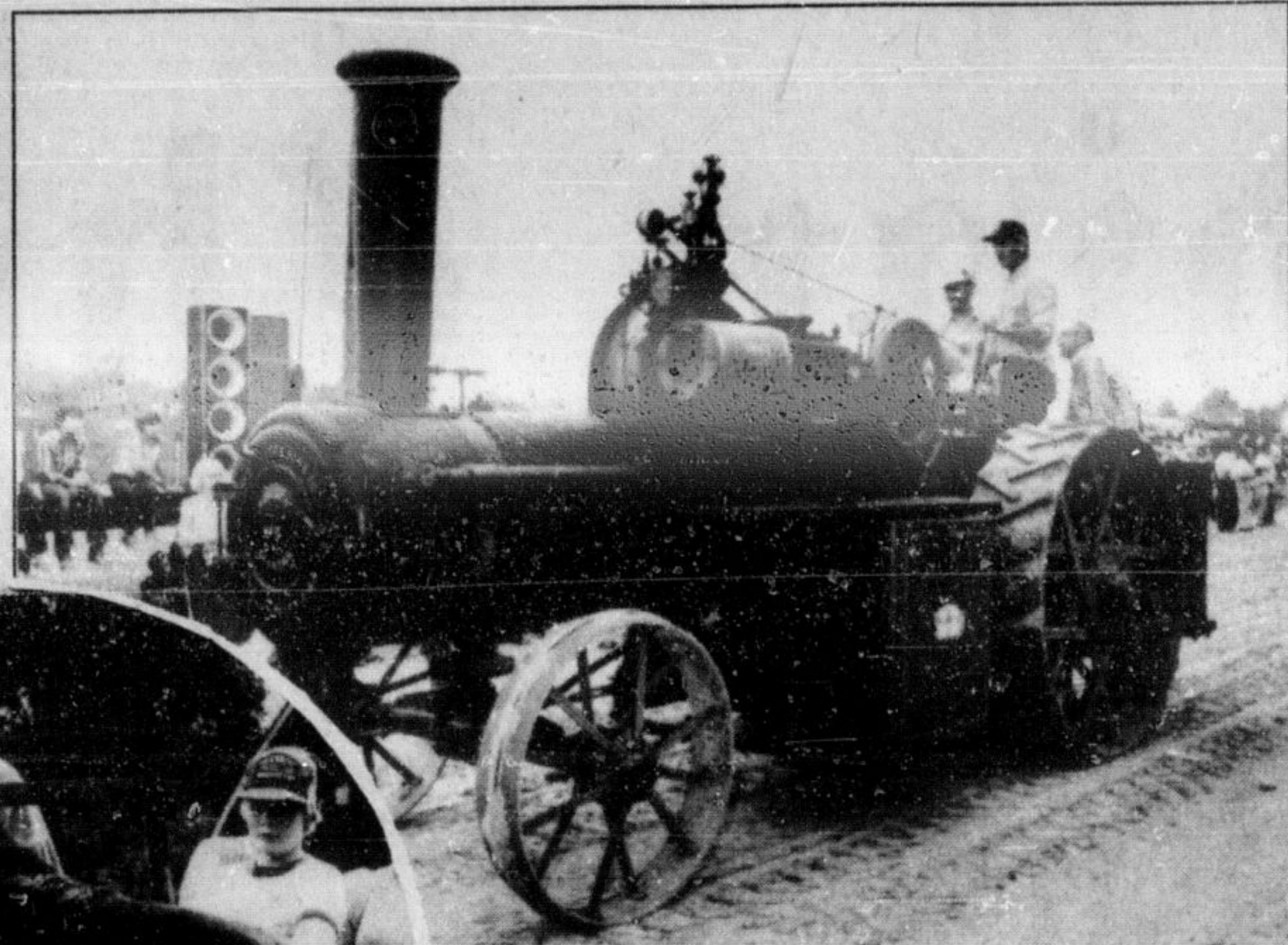


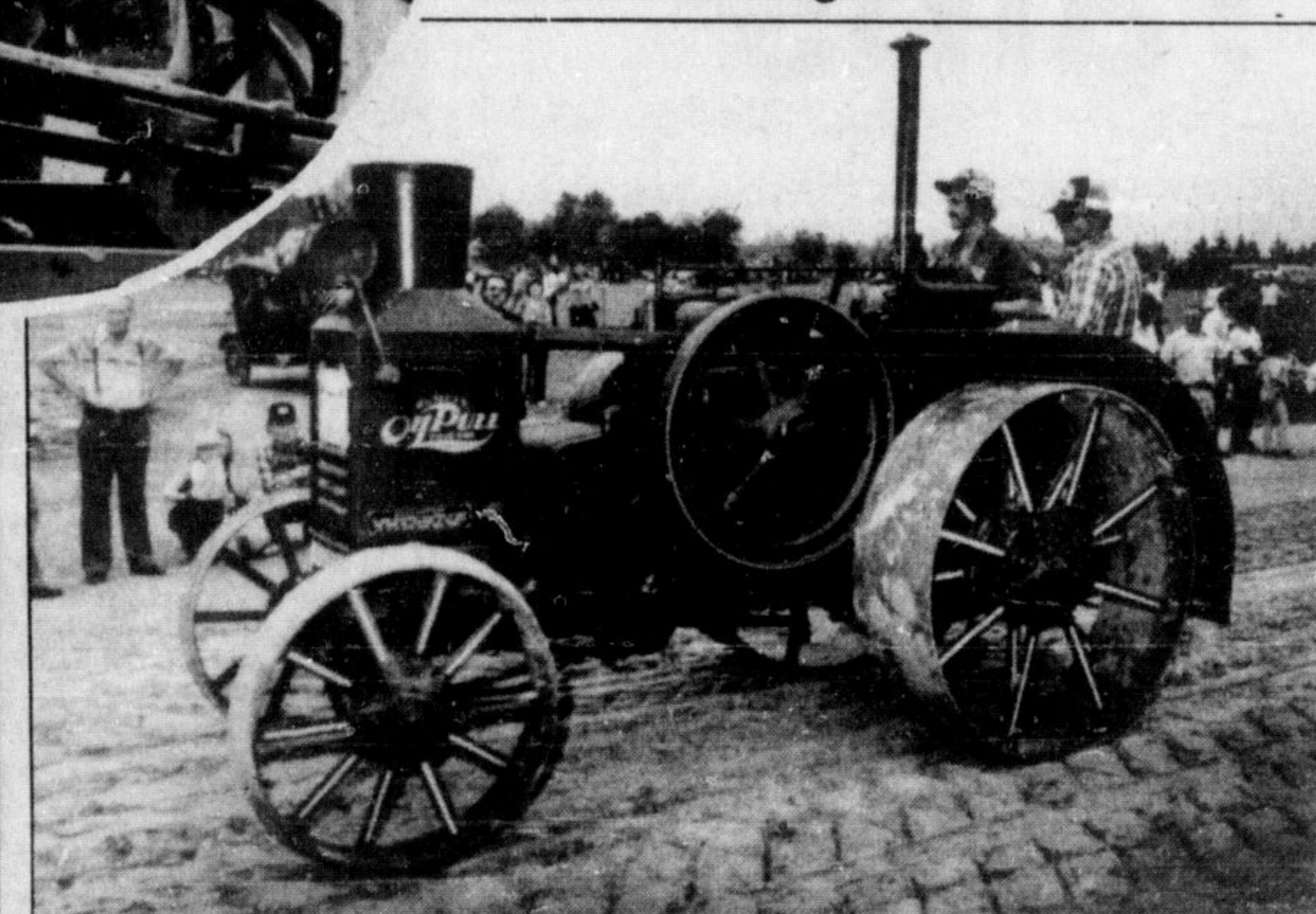
Family affair. The John Howe family of Trenton shows this antique Huber gas tractor at Steam-Era shows.



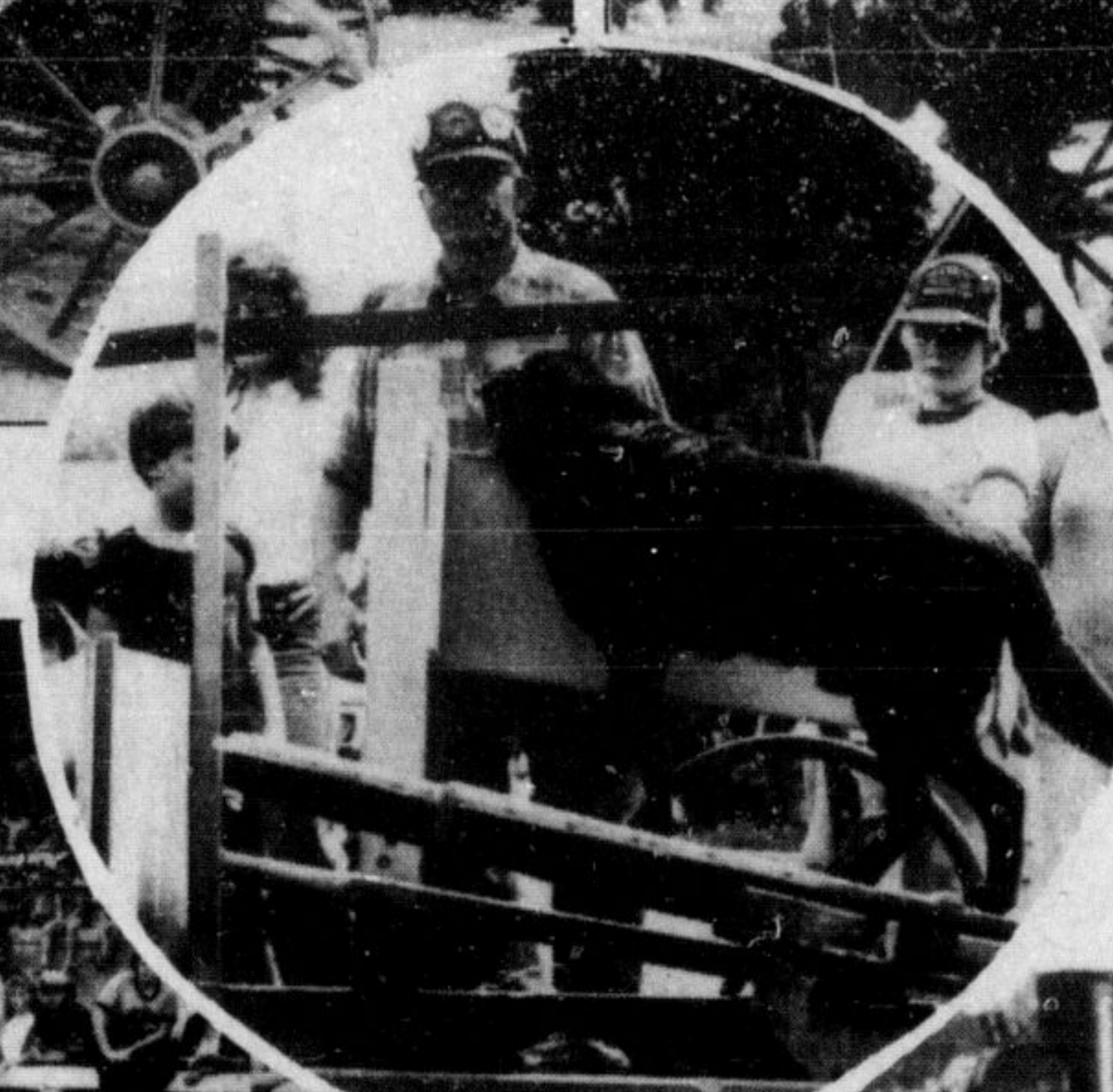
Unique machine. Bill Watson of Kilbride restored this George White steam engine by replacing the boiler with one from another steam engine.

## Bad news, good news

There's good news and bad news about the levels of heavy metals in Halton Region's sewage system. The bad news is that lead, copper, zinc, mercury, and cadmium are above acceptable levels.

The good news is that the amounts are being drastically reduced.

Public Works Director Bob Moore produced a report on heavy metals in the system to his committee, and while metals are above levels in some cases, he said he is positive in his approach to the report which shows a significant decrease.

In fact Mr. Moore said the Region is well on the way to having the best record in Ontario for reduction of pollutants, particularly in the sludge it is using on agricultural lands.

However, the committee received a surprise when it found out the atomic absorption analyzer, which was considered crucial to the heavy metal detection and tracking to source campaign, has been cancelled "due to budget restraints."

Committee Chairman Ron Planche said he was aghast at learning the special machinery had been cancelled to help shore up the region deficit make-good attempts when council has made a commitment to eliminate all heavy metals.

Public Works Committee has therefore scheduled as the first item at its next meeting the question of the cost of getting the analyzer back and forcing it through council.
