

Woman, 79, dies in Brampton crash

A 79-year-old Milton woman is dead and her daughter hospitalized following a two-car accident in Brampton last Wednesday.

Jessie Green of Birch Ave. was killed when the car she was driving collided with a second vehicle at the intersection of Fifth Line W. and Embledon Rd.

Mrs. Green's daughter, Norma Hull, 47, sustained multiple injuries.

Both Mrs. Hull and the driver of the second car, Cassie Ward, 22, of Georgetown were taken to Peel Memorial Hospital.

Mrs. Green had lived with her daughter and son-in-law Gord Hull, for the past three years on Birch Ave.

The mother and daughter were on their way to Brampton to pick up some apples.

Mrs. Green was buried in Galt following a service at McKersie Funeral Home.

Car slams into tree; two dead

A single car accident claimed the lives of two area men early Sunday morning.

Dead are Arthur Schwab, 30, of RR 1 Freelon and David Covert, 18, of 699 Marley, Unit 9, Burlington.

Both men died instantly when Mr. Schwab lost control of the 1971

MGB sports car he was driving and slammed head-on into a tree at the intersection of the Hamilton-Wentworth and Halton Town Line south of Steeles Ave.

Halton Regional Police said speeding was involved in the accident.

A resident of the area travelling home discovered

the accident and telephoned for help.

Milton Fire Department was called to the scene to pry both bodies from the wreck.

The accident marks the 31st traffic fatality in Halton this year, an increase of eight deaths over last year.

Teen's death mourned by his classmates

Milton District High School students paid their final respects at the funeral of a fellow classmate, Friday.

Seventeen-year-old Michael Bennett of R.R. 1, Moffat was killed instantly when he lost control of the car he was driving and smashed head-on into a tree on Steeles Ave. west of Twiss Rd. last Tuesday night.

Two passengers, brothers Patrick Condon, 15, and Sean, 18, were hospitalized with multiple injuries.

The trio were returning home from work at Mohawk Raceway in Campbellville where Michael was employed as a parking lot attendant.

There were no witnesses to the accident, but Halton Regional Police said the impact of the crash split the car in half.

"He was an all out, easy-going guy who wouldn't hurt anyone."

"He was always around cars. He loved to tinker with them. But he was a really considerate guy," he said.

The grade 12 student was a "very likeable young man" according to history teacher Ed Loeprich.

"I knew him as a quiet individual, but also

someone who always had a lot of friends around him. We are really going to miss him."

Michael was buried in Evergreen Cemetery following a service at McKersie Funeral Home.

The youth is survived by his parents Bruce and Joyce Bennett of Moffat, brother Danny and sister Donna.
