TOWN OF HALTON HILLS 1981 TAXES INTERIM BILLING

In accordance with the provisions of The Municipal Act pursuant to By-Law No. 81-22 adopted by Council on January 26th, 1981, the first two instalments of taxes for 1981 will become due as follows:

ALL WARDS	FIRST INSTALLMENT	SECOND INSTALLMENT
	FEBRUARY 25th, 1981	APRIL 29th, 1981

The above instalments represent an Interim Billing of 1981 taxes based upon one-half of last year's residential mill rates less the mill rate formally charged for Sewers in the former Towns of Acton and Georgetown. The Final tax bill will be issued about the middle of the year and will also be payable in two instalments.

Upon default of payment of the Interim Tax Levy as set out above, a penalty of one and one quarter (1 1/4) percent of the amount in default shall be added on the first day of default and on the first day of each and every calendar month.

Ratepayers who have not received a tax bill should make immediate application at 36 Main Street South, Georgetown, or by telephone (877-5185 or 453-2411).

These taxes may be paid at the locations and in the manner detailed on the back of the tax bill.
