

Cast of 146 presents 'Second Generation' at MDHS Friday to Sunday

Community members and Milton District High School students are joining forces for the first time to create a musical comedy called Second Generation to be presented Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

The cast of 146 dancers, singers and actors range in age from nine to 70.

The story deals with a relationship between an older distinguished man and a younger woman and the problem of family acceptance, according to musical director Judy Hunter.

"There are about five or six actual families involved," said Mrs. Hunter who teaches music at the high school.

Brenda Kearney, head of creative arts at Milton District choreographed the production which will include musical selections from Mame, Chorus

Line and Oklahoma. Ticket prices range from students and \$1 for \$3 for adults, \$2 for children.

we found it.

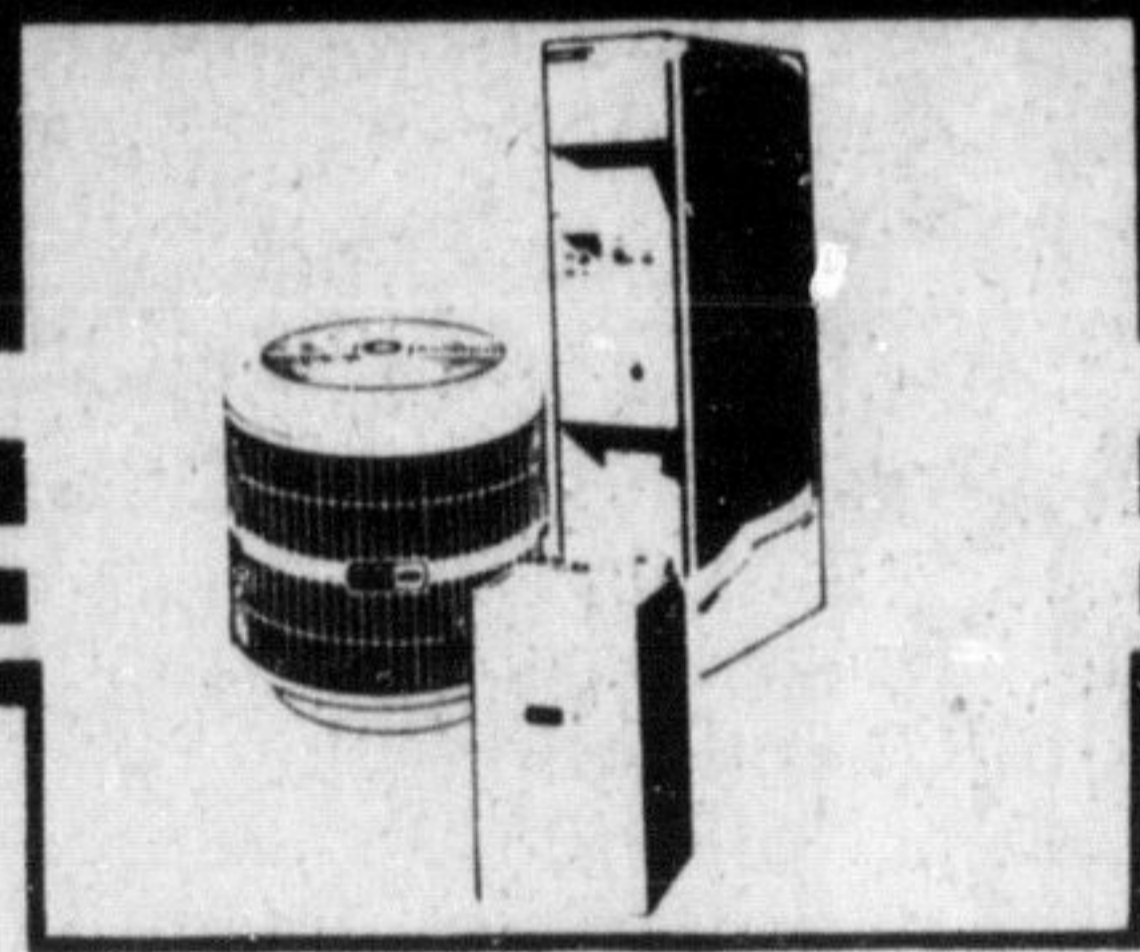

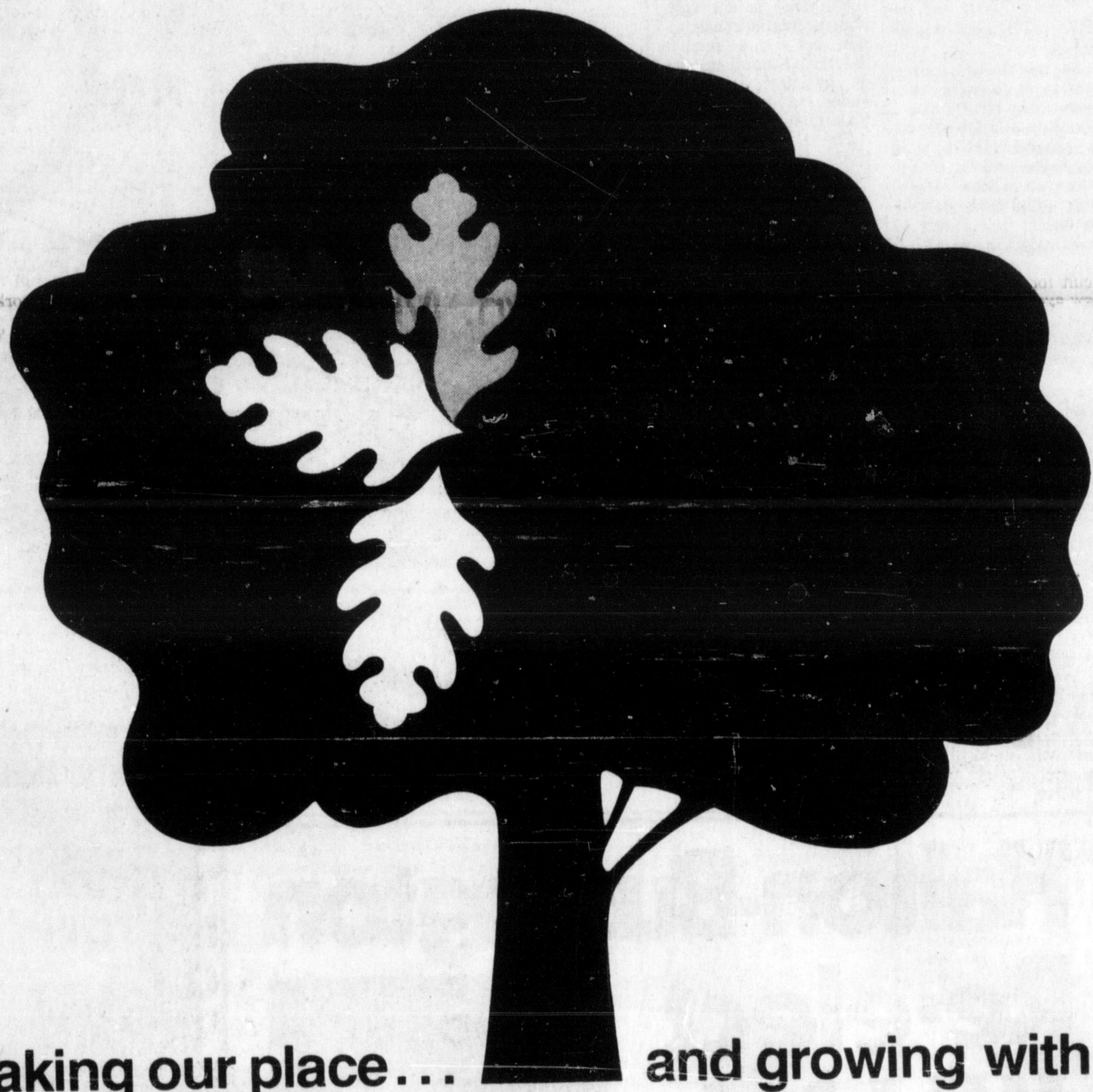
