

Pride is a very essential ingredient in a pizza made by Sam

"To me making pizza is an art. Besides, I don't make them, I create them," says the owner of Milton's newest pizzeria, "Sorrento's" at 190 Main St. Milton. As owner-manager and chief cook, he emphasizes a pro-

duct with a personal touch. The dough and sauce recipes are his own. And as far as he is concerned, pizza is anything but junk food.

"Pizza is one of the most wholesome meals if it is done right," he explained. "I don't cut any corners and only the best go in.' Never does he use frozen goods, he said, pointing out there

is no freezer on the premises. The Italian native has only recently developed a career in

the pizza business.

In fact, he has done everything else, but make pizza.

Twenty-four years ago he arrived in Canada with \$1.25 and a "Suitcase of dreams.

He has worked in factories, sold insurance and been a salesman in a number of fields.

"But never have I loved anything else as much as serving pizza and especially my pizza," he said.

Five years ago he opened a pizzeria with a partner in the United States called "Sam's".

"The response was good. People loved it. They were the happiest people to deal with. They told me they had never

had a pizza like mine." He decided to move back to Toronto and sparked by success and the encouragement of happy customers he made plans to open his own pickup and delivery shop in Milton. Standing behind a hot oven for him is no chore. Quite simp-

ly, he loves his work. "I love people, I love to serve them and I love to hear their comments. They can be good or bad comments. I just want to

hear them.' And there are no limits on what creations Sam Catenaro will come up with.

If a customer has a particular preference, a favorite ingre-

dient, Sam will make it. "The customer names it and I make it."

"I like to see somebody walk away enjoying my food," he said. "That is why I emphasize personal service." The shop was named by his wife, Loretta, after the small

picturesque town of Sorrento on the Gulf of Naples. The town, a favorite spot with Sam Catenaro is located just 80 miles away from his birth place.

Although it is Sam who is up each morning to knead the dough and prepare the sauce for the pizzas, his wife also plays an important role in the operation.

A full-time sewing machine operator in a Toronto factory, she comes home each evening and prepares the lasagna, ravioli, gnocchi, canneloni, spaghetti and rigatoni that are also sold in the pizzeria.

Like her husband, she takes considerable pride in her culinary delights and allows nobody else to prepare the The couple have two sons, Mario, 18 and Tony, 14, who help

out in the shop on occasion. But Sorrento's remains very much a husband-and-wife team effort.

"My wife and I love this. It is something we would hate to give to anybody else to do, who doesn't feel the same enjoy-

ment as we do in preparing the food," explained the owner. There are no plans to open any more pizzerias he said. He worries a larger operation would mean less personal service.

A Toronto resident, he does plan to eventually move to Milton. The couple have fast made friends in the town and he is full of praise for its residents.
