CAS strike

A strike that would cripple the Halton Children's Aid Society has probably been averted. Negotiators from the Canadian Union of Public Employees, which represents the 45 Halton CAS workers, met with CAS managers and a mediator in Toronto last Thursday and both sides emerged from the day's talks feeling that a settlement had been worked out.

However, Halton CAS board of directors and the union membership must okay the agreement this week before it can be ratified. "It appears for the moment we have relieved the pending strike crisis," said Halton CAS executive director Ron Coupland, adding, "the strike is still a possibility, however."

Gord Allan, negotiator for CUPE, said, "I think it is a good deal." He said his membership has been in a position to strike since last Sunday, but he hoped they would ratify the agreement at a meeting tomorrow night. Coupland and Allan agreed that meeting with mediator Paul Gardiner

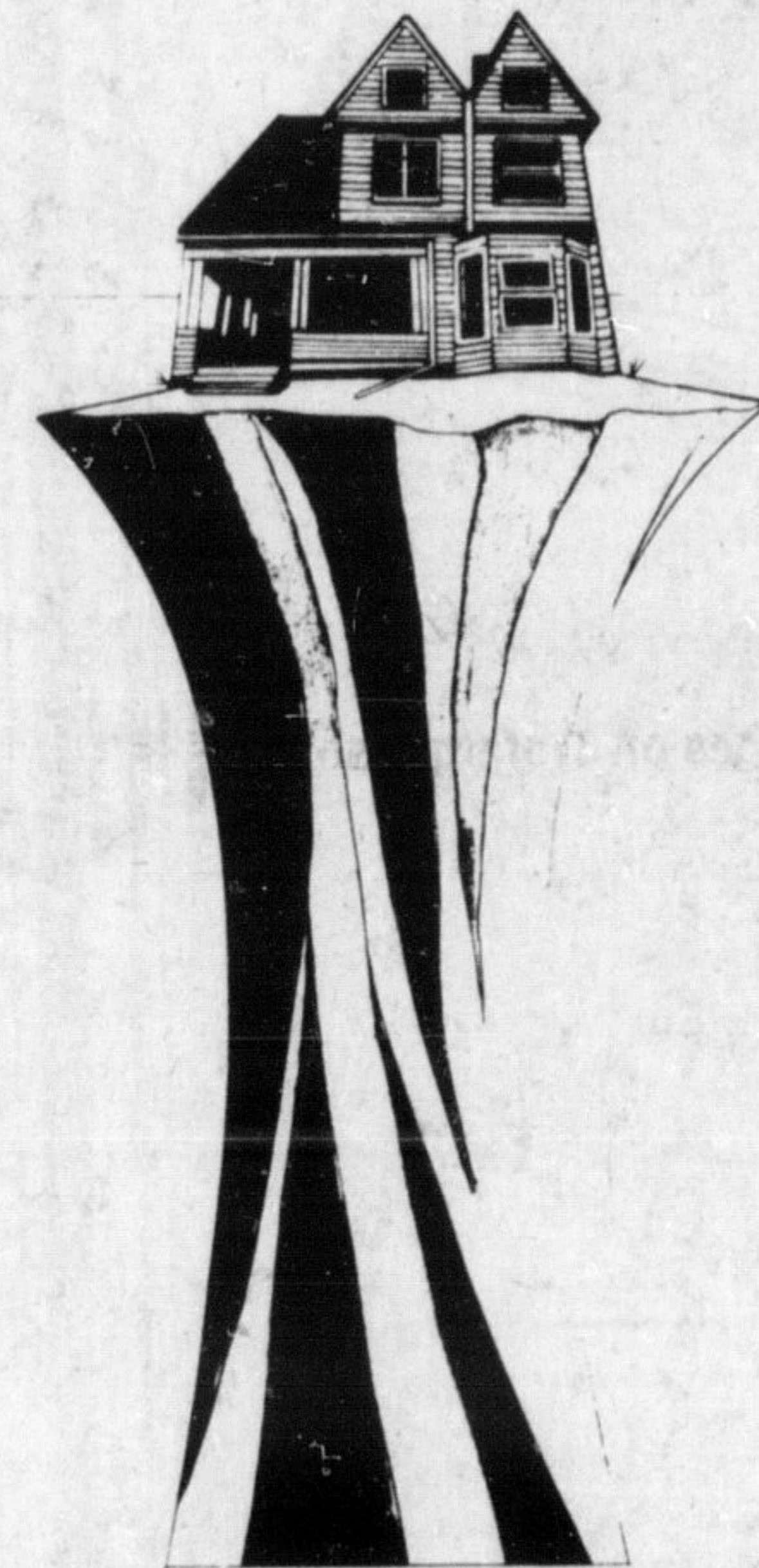
