#### **CLEMENT'S PAINT** AND WALLPAPER

A tradition in the home decorating field is being carried on at Clement's Paint and Wallpaper store on Main St. Boyne (William) Clement has operated his downtown business since the early part of this century. His experience began while working as a painter with his father Harry.

The father and son team redecorated many homes in the area together, even before the products they used were retailed by Boyne.

The store has changed over the years, and has seen two locations on Main St. Once located where Harris Stationery is now, one could find many home improvement and decorating At its present location, 197 Main St., the store offers much

more than before. In 1959, Boyne Clement diversified to include the motor vehicle licence bureau at the rear of his store. Shortly after licences could be obtained there, the building was expanded

through a rear addition. Boyne's daughter Colleen, who has been working at her father's store for nine years, said he has noticed an extreme increase in the number of licences sold at the store as the town has grown.

In fact, the increased business has made her consider another expansion, this time to the currently unused basement which opens onto the rear parking lot. Betty Clement, Colleen's mother decided the store needed

to sell more than paint and wallpaper so greeting cards and china were added to the inventory. "In winter, decorating slowed down and cards were good sellers," said Colleen.

She has taken over where her mother left off. "I like good china," she said.

She visits a major Toronto china show twice a year to shop for gift items which now almost prevail in the front portion of the store. Everything from Hummel figurines to Royal Albert china

and collector plates can be found at Clement's. "I was surprised at the number of people collecting plates," Colleen recalls.

Besides being a showroom for gift items, the store offers a number of services such as picture framing, glass and key

A decorator's delight can be found in the selection of Sherwin Williams paints in stock and many major brands of wallpaper. It doesn't stop there however; paint brushes, rollers and all the accessories for home decorating are available.

A family business, bearing a family name, Clement's Paint and Wallpaper has employed every member of Boyne's family through the years. Bruce, his 18-year-old son, works part time after school, as did his older brother Stephen who now lives near North Bay.

Handcrafted baby quilts adorn the walls of the store and pinwheel crystal enhances its shelves.

Colleen feels their store offers personal service not usually associated with newer businesses. She said the store has the advantage of long standing customers and years of service.

Even during the Second World War, while Boyne was in Nova Scotia serving his country the doors of the store did not close. His brother-in-law Jack Hannant looked after customers during his absence.

Clement's Paint and Wallpaper has changed in the past and the store could experience a facelift if plans go through. Colleen said she spoke with Peter Turner of the consulting team hired by Milton Civic Committee to improve the look of

She is hoping to see some ideas for improving the store's facade in the form of a sketch from Mr. Turner. No matter what the look, the store will go on offering the

same selection of decorating supplies as well as a broadening line of gift items, china and crystal.




