Daycare cost may pay off in long run

Helping to get single parents back on their feet by providing day care may cost the taxpayers now, but will save them a lot later, according to Norma Lepa, co-ordinator for Regional day care services.

Speaking to the newly formed North Halton Social Planning Council at Hillcrest Church, Thursday evening, Lepa said the help a single parent gets at the beginning of marriage break-up is critical.

Mrs. Lepa, who says the Region day care budget is in the neighborhood of \$880,000, feels helping working single parents by providing day care while they work or are taking a retraining program is often the key to making them self-sufficient.

"If we can get the mother at the time of marriage breakdown, when she may have to go on the locally paid general welfare, and provide day care so she can train or look for a job, we can stop the cycle at the general welfare level before they move on to the provincially funded family benefits," Lepa maintained.

With family benefits it often gives the mother little incentive to look for a job and does nothing for her self confidence and esteem.

"It's a poor model for

then to stay together it happening but these these days. It's sad to see parents need help to get

through the critical years feeling good about them- and back on their feet, selves," Lepa said.

Opinions differ

A joint meeting on "deficiencies" at Halton Centennial Manor has again been postponed, this time until May 12 on a recommendation of Halton's Chief Administrator Dennis Perlin.

The meeting will consist of members of the Halton Health and Social Services Committee, Ministry of Community and Social Services representatives, and Halton Manor staff including Administrator Jack Charlton.

The meeting was to have been held April 7. The committee met with Mr. Charlton March 10 to look at what had

been done regarding 142 "deficiencies" at the Manor, most of which were of a minor nature.

Mr. Perlin said "there were a number of recommendations that had been implemented, a number of others where action was still ongoing, and a number of others where no action had been implemented."

"There was a difference of opinion between the Ministry staff and the Manor staff on the number of issues, as to whether certain actions had actually been completed or where Manor staff indicated that action was ongoing."
