

Lung group needs help

The increase in postal rates has caused a sharp decline in the Christmas Seal Campaign.

Only once before, in 1975 when the postal strike was in effect, has the Halton Lung Association been forced to ask for more help. Halton citizens are aware that programs carried on in the community are much too valuable to be cut back. Summer day camps for asthmatic children, better breathing clubs for adults suffering from emphysema or some other respiratory disease, smoking withdrawal clinics, continuing education for health professionals, education programs in schools, family asthma programs, research, lung capacity testing in industry, rehabilitation for chronic lung patients are provided free of charge to all Halton citizens because they are supported by Halton citizens who contribute to the Christmas Seal Campaign.

To date, the association is \$17,000 short of its goal and the campaign ends officially Jan. 31, 1982. It depends solely on its mail campaign to finance the programs. AROUND THE HOUSE



If you use corrugated boxes to store clothing, prepare the interior of the boxes with a coat of thinned shellac to prevent dampness from penetrating and destroying them.

Stainless steel flatware, while tarnish-proof, will pit if stored with sterling silver. Separate them when storing and washing in a dishwasher.

Toothpaste rubbed on piano keys will keep them sparkling clean. Use a soft, damp cloth to apply, then buff with a clean, dry cloth.

Storing a carpet? Be sure the ends of the roll are covered so that vermin don't nest inside. If the carpet is unwrapped, slip a large bag over each end and secure to rug with tape.

Hard-to-remove sink stains may go away if scrubbed with two tablespoons salt mixed well into a cup of turpentine.

The federal government is using everything in its power to kill rental construction, says the head of an area real estate board.
 And the board has joined forces with other real estate associations and builders to lobby for changes in the budget.
 "The government is impeding rental construction instead of stimulating it," said Jeff Peth, president of the Metropolitan Real Estate Board. "They will say that they have committed themselves to 100,000 units, but that won't even be enough to make a dent on the vacancy rate in the major cities."
 Mr. Peth said a healthy market should have a three per cent vacancy rate—Burlington's rate is hovering around 0.3.
 "If we can show that the budget will make it worse, and if we can apply enough pressure through a united front, I think there is a chance the government will back down."
