

Sewer study conducted

A major study of Halton's sewer system should be carried out to ensure that taxpayers are financing the treatment of large amounts of rain water.

Members of the Region's planning and public works committee supported the idea last week of carrying out the study and urged that it be forwarded to a joint committee of Regional staff and officials from

the provincial Ministry of the Environment. While the recommendation put forward by public works director Bob Moore was for a broad study of different areas in the region, committee members decided to restrict the study to Oakville—where the largest problems appear to be. "We have a major problem in Oakville and, yet, this proposal is to

look at only 20 per cent of the problem," commented Burlington Coun. Ted MacDonald. sanitary sewer system was first raised by Oakville Coun. Terry

Mannell, who wondered if the Region was expanding its sewage treatment capacity to treat large amounts of rainwater. "We didn't feel we

could tell the Ministry of the Environment to study the entire region, so this seems to be the most expedient way to attack the problem," commented Mr. Moore.

Enrolment increases at community colleges

Enrolment at Ontario's 22 colleges of applied arts and technology has reached a record high of 103,806 full-time students, up 3.1 per cent from 1980.

The new high was recorded despite a 12.1 per cent drop in students attending federally funded adult training classes and a 4.4 per cent decline in federally funded full-time instruction for registered apprentices. Registration in provincially-funded post-secondary programs jumped 6.5 per cent and there was a 2 per cent hike in full-time enrolment in short programs.

New service for disabled

The Halton Regional Health Department has announced a new service for chronically disabled residents of Halton.

Anyone with a specific health problem requiring specially designed equipment, or materials, is eligible for Ontario Sales Tax Exemption on these necessities.

Some articles require a Doctor's prescription, others may be obtained without an accompanying prescription. This does not include first aid materials.

To obtain an Identification Card for purposes of Sales Tax Exemption and an accompanying information package, interested persons are asked to send a Doctor's letter which indicates that they have a chronic disability including the diagnosis to:
