### You and Your Child Development

As children grow, they all go through certain stages in their development. When parents know what to expect from their child at a certain age, they are better prepared to deal with it.

From birth to age one, children are entirely dependent upon their parents. They need to be held, cuddled, and talked to. They are dependent upon their parents to satisfy their every need. At this age, children need to be allowed to be completely dependent upon their parents, because this prepares them for steps toward independence. Parents should not try to teach a baby who's boss by letting him cry too long. What they are teaching him is that the world is a cold, cruel place, and will result in the child remaining dependent, and demanding of attention indefinitely.

Toddlers between the ages of 1 and 3 vacillate between dependence and independence. They develop a sense of autonomy, and learn that they aren't part and parcel of their mother. These children want to touch and explore the world around them—it's part of their learning how to learn. When toddlers achieve a new skill, it makes them feel "big". When parents acknowledge the toddler's new accomplishment with, "What a big boy!", it makes the child want to try even harder to be "bigger". These children learn to walk, talk, use the toilet, and remember. They should be allowed to make simple choices such as what toy they would like to play with, and whether they would like dessert after dinner. This is when children learn to say "No!" in an attempt to exert control over their environment.

Pre-school children between the ages of 3 and 5 begin to refine their skills of self-direction and self-control. They are more self sufficient and easier to live with. These children like to present their own ideas, such as the clothes they would like to wear, or the glass and plate they would like to use for lunch. Their ideas should be accepted, because when parents put down their children's ideas, it tends to kill their initiative to do their own thinking and planning. At this age, children are old enough to share in duties around the house, and this is when their attitudes about completing tasks are established. This is also the age when children begin to make friends with others their age.
